Program: Community Health, Gerontology Concentration
Degree: Associate in Science in Community Health

Receiving College: New York City College of Technology (NYCCT)
Department: School of Professional Studies
Program: Health Services Administration (HSA)
Degree: Bachelor of Science

Admission requirements for Bachelor of Science in Health Services Administration:

An associate degree in a health science program of study with a minimum grade point average of 2.5, and appropriate Licensure or Certification in hand or pending;

OR

An associate degree from a program that has an articulation agreement with the NYCCT HSA program with a minimum grade point average of 2.5;

OR

An associate degree with a minimum grade point average of 2.5, and at least five years of alternative work experience in a health care setting or related field as determined by the HSA program coordinator.

Articulation with the Community Health Program, (Gerontology Concentration) at Kingsborough Community College with the New York City College of Technology's Bachelor of Science in Health Services Administration is based upon the following transfer of credits:

Transferred credits will be applied to the Baccalaureate degree as professional credits, required courses and electives. Students will meet with a faculty advisor who will review their transcripts to ensure proper placement within the program.

Procedures for reviewing, up-dating, modifying or terminating this agreement:

When either of the programs undergo any changes, this articulation agreement will be reviewed and revised as necessary by one or two members of the faculty of each institution's department, selected by their respective Chairpersons, to represent them.

At the end of semester the various representatives of each institution as indicated above will review the performance of the transfer students to determine if adjustments to, or termination of the articulation agreement is warranted.

Procedures for evaluating the agreement and tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their academic success:

At the end of each semester the receiving program, in order to follow the progress of transfer students, shall generate a log indicating:

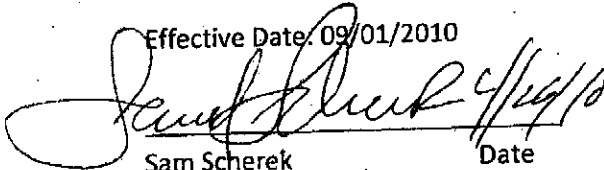
1. The names and number of students who transfer under the agreement.
2. The total number of credits completed to date and the grade point average for the semester of attendance.
3. The cumulative grade point average of the transfer students

The log will be made available to the transfer advisor for the students as well as the Departmental Chairperson and Dean of both institutions for their assessments.

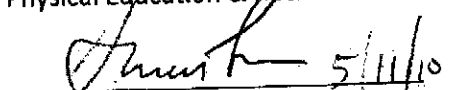
Publicizing the agreement:

3. The articulation agreement will be publicized by the transfer student advisors.

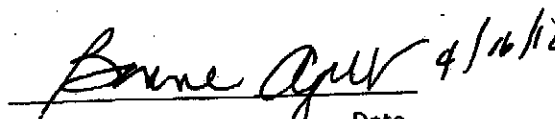
