Pass the CUNY Assessment Tests in Reading, Writing, and Math or satisfy all requirements for existing developmental coursework.</b></li><li><b>2. Students must complete BIO 1100, MAT 900, and PSG 100 with a minimum grade of "C"</b></li><li><b>3. Formal interview with the Program Director</b></li></ol>

**Rationale**

In the past students were permitted to directly enter the Polysomnographic Technology program without having any prerequisite courses. Currently there is no written policy regarding admission into the program. To strengthen both the pool of students and to bolster the students ability to be successful in the program a definite policy for admission into the Polysomnographic Technology program is necessary. Passing BIO 1100, MAT 900 and PSG 100 with a grade of "C" or better are good indicators of students' ability.
