Executive Summary

Enrollment Summary:

Kingsborough has experienced significant enrollment declines since the 2014-2015 academic year. Between 2014-2015 and 2018-2019, Fall enrollments decreased by 15% and Spring enrollments declined by 24%. Although most groups had declines, enrollments for freshmen, male students, black and Hispanic students, and students between 20 and 30 years of age decreased more than other groups (Table 1).

Retention Gaps:

Compounding the enrollment decline are the trends in retention rates. Those groups showing the largest declines are also those with the lowest retention rates: Male students, black and Hispanic students, and students of traditional college age. Pell recipients, students with a balance of more than \$100, and students with lower GPAs or less than 15 and more than 60 cumulative credits earned, also had lower retention rates (Table 2).

Retention Trends:

Overall Fall to Spring retention rates declined from 75% in 2017-2018 to 70.5% in 2018-2019. The declines in retention rates were more pronounced for the same groups that experienced the largest enrollment decreases. In addition, the Engineering Science; Graphic Design; Physical Education, Recreation and Recreation Therapy (PERRT); and Tourism and Hospitality programs experienced particularly large retention decreases, while Fashion Design, Journalism, and Community Health saw slight increases (Table 3).

Majors and Concentrations:

Most majors experienced enrollment decreases. Many of the majors where enrollment went down the most also saw significant drops in retention. Fine Arts, Liberal Arts, Media Arts, PERRT, Speech Communication, and Tourism and Hospitality all experienced enrollment drops greater than 30% between Fall of 2014 and Fall of 2018, in addition to declines in retention. The only majors that increased were Culinary Arts, Computer Science, and Computer Information Systems (Table 4).

Spring 2019 Enrollment Profile:

Compared to Spring 2018, the mean number of cumulative credits earned by Spring 2019 students was slightly higher (33.9 and 34.4 respectively). However, much of this increase can be attributed to the rise in the percentage of students who have accumulated 60 or more credits (Table 5).

Table 1. Enrollment SummaryChange from 2014-2015 to 2018-2019

- From 2014-2015 to 2018-2019, headcount enrollment decreased 15% in Fall and 24% in Spring.
- This was true regardless of gender, ethnicity, age, or full-time/part-time attendance status, and academic major.
- The decline was greater among new freshmen than new transfer students.
- In the last year fall-to-spring retention declined five percentage points, compounding the enrollment shortfall (See Table 3).
