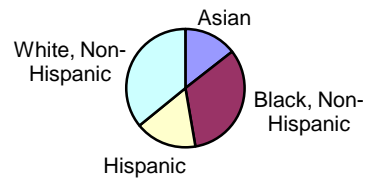

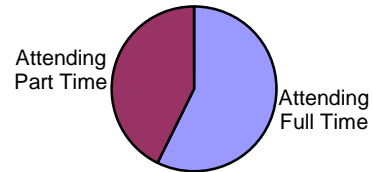

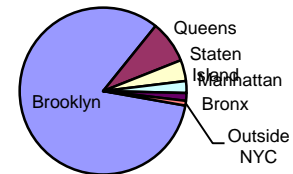

**J. Full- or Part-Time Status**



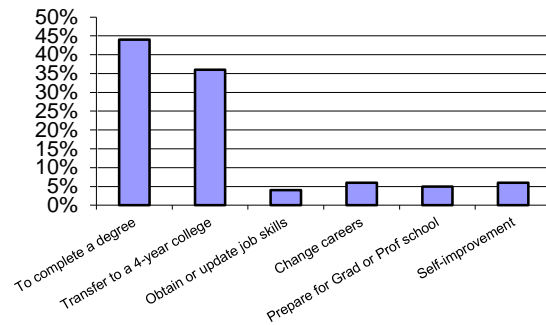

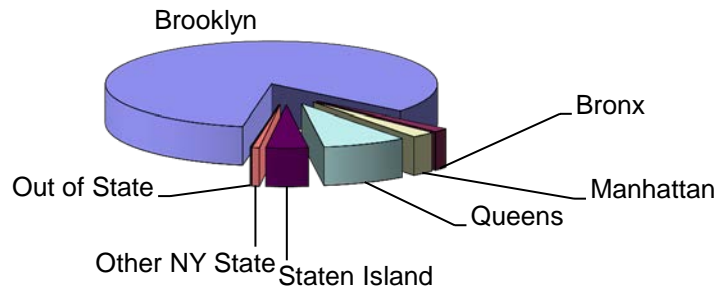

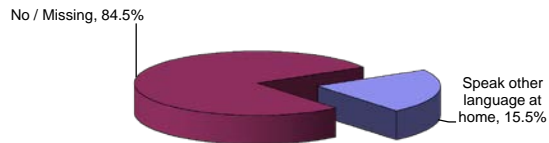

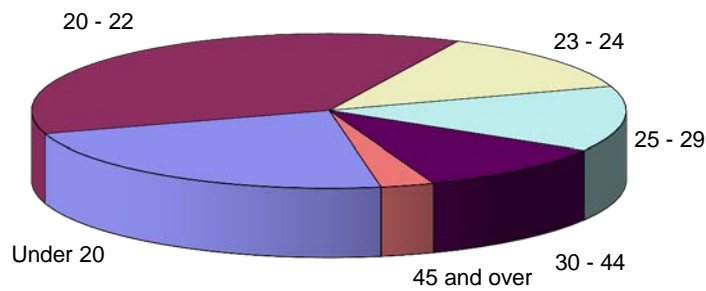

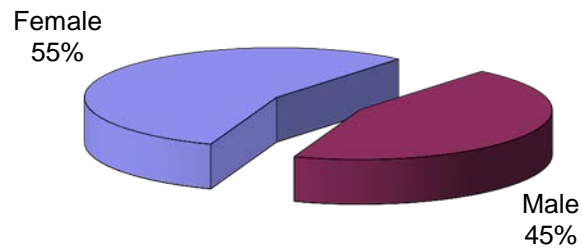

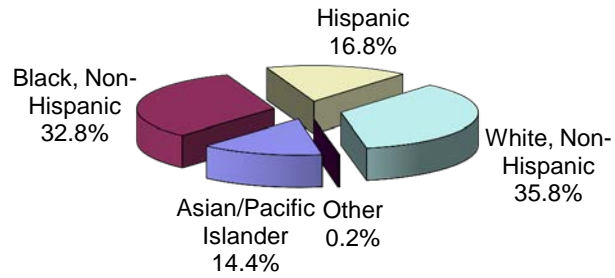

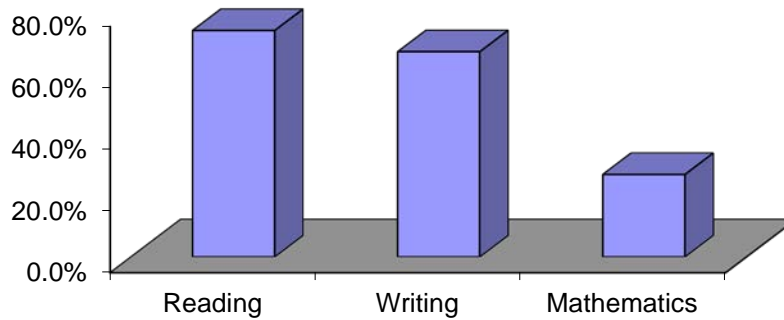

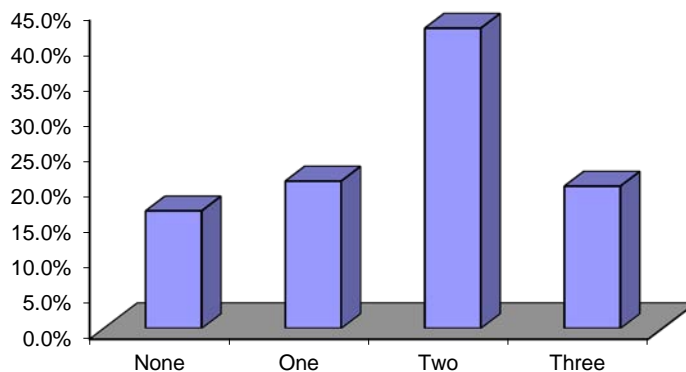

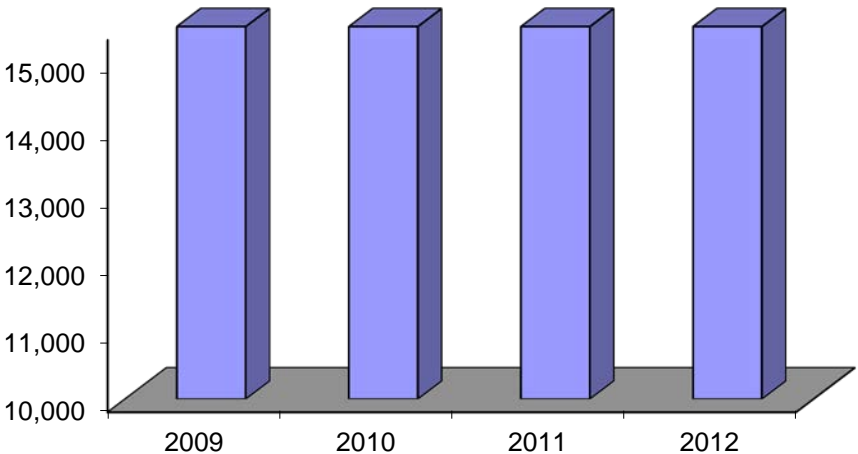

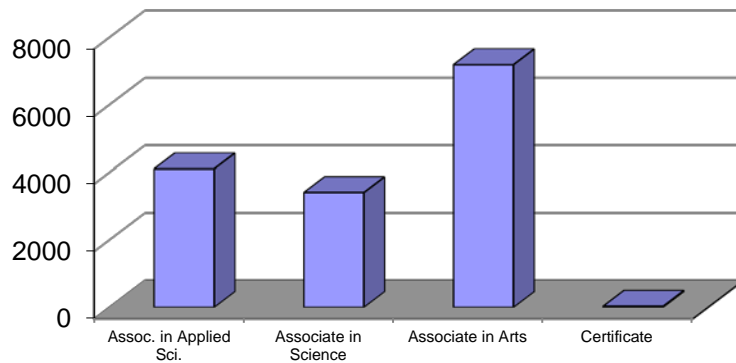

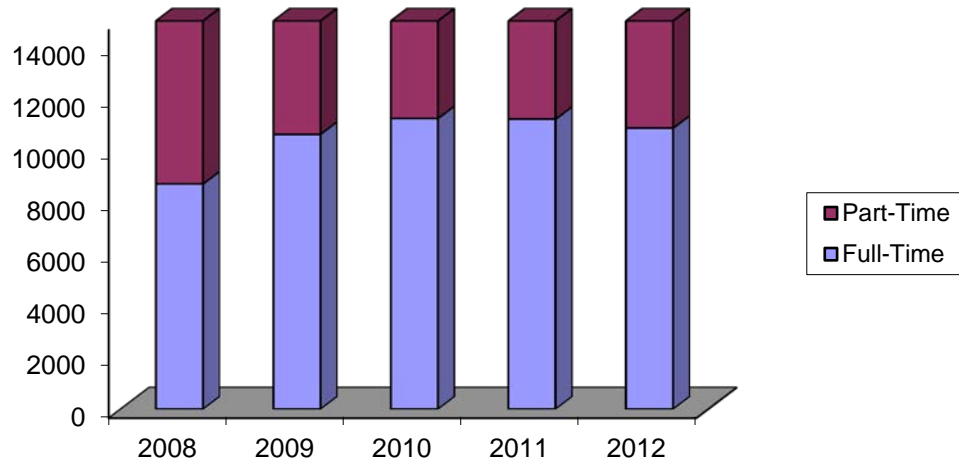

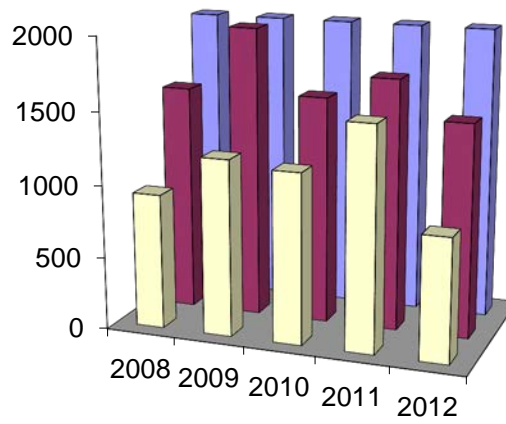

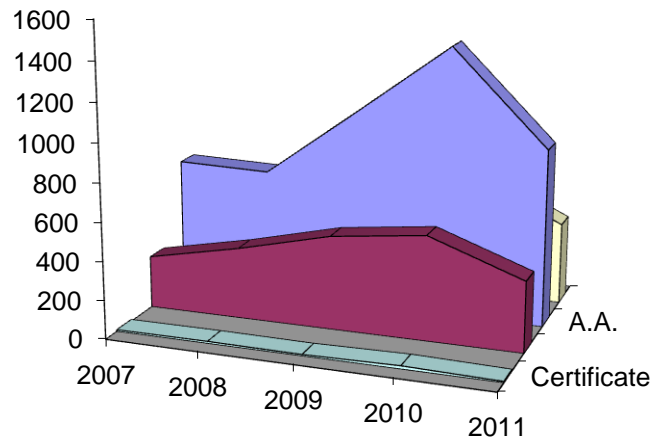

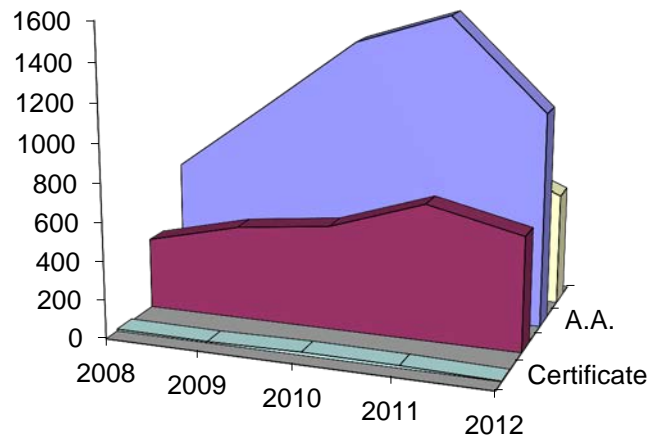

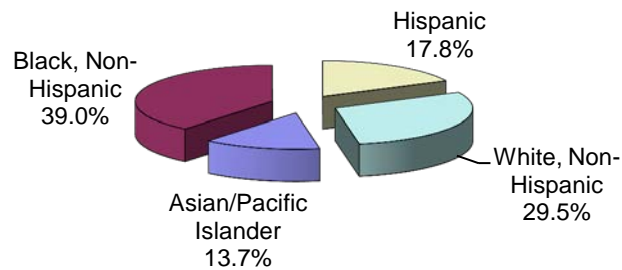
