

New Deferred Action for Young People

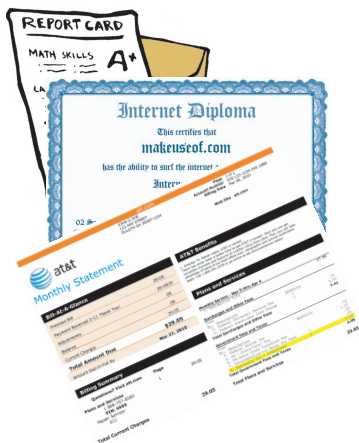
In order to apply for this new deferred action, individuals must:

- ▶ Have come to the United States **under the age of sixteen**
 - ▶ Have continuously resided **in the United States for five years** before **June 15, 2012** and be present in the U.S. on **June 15, 2012**
 - ▶ **In School, graduated from high school, or have a GED**
 - ▶ **Not have been convicted of a felony or significant misdemeanor or multiple misdemeanors**
 - ▶ **Not be above the age of thirty**

U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS)
will begin the process by AUGUST 15, 2012.
