New Deferred Action for Young People

In order to apply for this new deferred action, individuals must:

- ▶ Have come to the United States under the age of sixteen
- Have continuously resided in the United States for five years before June 15, 2012 and be present in the U.S. on June 15, 2012
- In School, graduated from high school, or have a GED
- Not have been convicted of a felony or significant misdemeanor or multiple misdemeanors
- Not be above the age of thirty

U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) will begin the process by AUGUST 15, 2012.
