- Assignments:
  - Service Learning Report Write about the agency and its mission, a
    description of the project you were involved in, and your experiences doing this
    assignment (minimum 5 complete pages)
    - I. Due on date determined by Honors Program
  - Service-learning experience presentation to full Community Health Interventions class followed by a Question and Answer period
    - I. Due on date determined between you and Dr. Nanín

Students who receive a grade of B+ or higher for this additional work **and** as their final grade in the course will receive an Honors notation on their transcript.
