

**ACC 6000: Microcomputer Accounting Applications** (3 credit course)  
(Prerequisite: Acc 1200 and BA 6000)

This course is asynchronous. You will learn how to use Quickbooks by following the specific instructions in the lab manual, and by watching videos and using the Brightspace resources.

**BULLETIN DESCRIPTION:**

The use of accounting system software as a tool for processing accounting data into financial information. Accounting system topics include the accounting cycle, general ledger, sales and account receivable, purchasing and payment, payroll, inventory, account reconciliation, financial reporting and budget analysis.

**STUDENT OUTCOMES:**

1. Identify and define the terminology used in computerized accounting systems
2. Record transactions in the accounting cycle including purchases, sales, payments, and receivables.
3. Perform typical accounting tasks with software for small to medium businesses including adjusting entries, closing procedures, bank reconciliation and inventory adjustments,
4. Perform payroll tasks using Quickbooks.
