ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- 1. Speech Language Pathology (SLP) majors at Brooklyn College have grade minimums for courses before they can proceed to the next tier of courses. Students must complete Speech 1113, 1178, 1179 and 2231 with an average of B and no grade lower than C before they can register for either 2481 or 3381. The KCC grades for the 1113 and 2231 equivalents (KCC Speech 40 and 41 respectively) will be computed into the BC averaging. Students who fail to maintain the grade minimum at KCC will be required to re-take the course(s) at BC in order to achieve a satisfactory grade.
- 2. Beginning January 2007, all KCC transfer students must maintain a 3.0 GPA at Brooklyn College. KCC students transferring who do not have a 3.0 GPA will be given one semester at Brooklyn College to achieve a 3.0 GPA.
- 3. All required SLP courses at Brooklyn College require pre-registration permission.
