

CLINICAL INFORMATION:

- You must wear the KCC blue uniform to clinical. It is available to purchase @ Ideal Uniform Store, 1816 Flatbush Avenue, Brooklyn, New York, 11217, 718-252-5090. Your KCC ID should be always visible and worn on the outside of your uniform. There are options for religious observers (blue long skirt, long sleeve undershirt for under ladies scrub top).
- Refer to the KCC Nursing Student Handbook for information regarding the uniform and dress requirements.
- Students are not allowed to do their clinical rotation where they are *employed*. It is the student's responsibility to notify the nursing office prior to the first day of class if there is a conflict.
- A copy of proof of influenza vaccination must be brought to the clinical agency on the first clinical day.
- ALL students must have completed all CastleBranch health clearances, including background check, verification of Influenza Vaccination, and a valid CPR certification prior to the start of classes.
- All clinical rotations are at assigned times.
- Bring blank copies of the Unfolding Care Plan to clinical every week.

- CUNY provides malpractice insurance for all nursing students.
- You are required to complete an unfolding care plan each week in clinical. Details will be given by your clinical instructor. Have a blank one with you on each clinical day.
