
Enrollment Management Update – January 2022 1/3/2022

Below are the enrollment numbers <u>as of December 31, 2021.</u> College Now enrollment does <u>not</u> generate FTE's for the college and tends to enroll most of their students <u>after</u> the semester has started.



• Welcome Back!

 For those who were able to take some time off during the holidays welcome back and Happy New Year! We are looking forward to a great semester ahead as we begin our Winter 2022 classes today!

• Winter 2022

On Wednesday, December 22nd, we dropped <u>99</u> students from their in-person or hybrid courses who failed to upload their vaccination information by December 20, 2021.
Students received information encouraging them to register for online courses and to ensure that their vaccination information is uploaded in time for Spring 2022 classes.

Last date to upload your vaccination information before being dropped: Spring 2022 Wednesday, February 23, 2022 Summer 2022 Friday, June 10, 2022

- Students were cautioned that if they <u>re-register</u> for an in-person or hybrid course in the Winter, they will be dropped again. Registrar will continue to review the list of students registered and drop any who have not complied with the vaccination policy.
- Fall 2022
 - Admissions has received their first recommendation file for Fall 2022. The team will be reaching out to students to notify them that there's still time to apply and register for Spring 2022 in order to invite them to start earlier. Students who are interested will have their applications moved to Spring 2022 and be invited to meet with an advisor.

• International Students

 International students who wish to acquire an I20 visa to enter the country and study, must show that they have registered for at least one hybrid or in-person class. Colleges must guarantee this in writing, in order for their visa to be processed.

• Recruitment Life

 An online survey has been sent to all of our Recruitment Life volunteers to gauge their interests. This information will be utilized to match volunteers to upcoming recruitment events, which will begin in mid-January.
