

College Center -U Building Power Disruption

May 17, 2022

The Campus Community,

This morning, a high voltage electrical switch burned out causing power loss to some HVAC equipment in College Center -U building. Our Electricians secured the electrical supply to prevent equipment damage. We are scheduling to replace the faulty equipment tonight at 6:00 p.m. To safely conduct this new installation, all power must be turned off to College Center -U Building only, for the duration of the repair. All other campus buildings will have power as normal. We anticipate all power restored and all other equipment operational to College Center -U Building by 1:00 a.m.

I.T. is requesting all computers, copiers and printers be powered off by 5:30 p.m. Staff connecting remotely to their computers in College Center -U Building will not have access during the electrical repair. Staff can still access email via Web and VDI, but not their desktops in their offices. I.T. will make rounds to restore remote access Wednesday morning.
