Changes to the A.A.S. Degree Requirement in Fashion Design

## **Change in Degree Requirement**

Change degree requirement from "FM 3500" (Textile and Non-textile Analysis) to "BF 3500"

## Rationale

This is merely a technical course name change require in order to maintain consistency with new course designations in the new Business of Fashion Degree (formerly, Retail Merchandising). With an overhaul of the Retail Merchandising Degree and its transformation to the "Business of Fashion" (or, "BF" degree), this Fashion Design course requirement has a new designation. There are no substantive changes to any underlying FD degree requirement or course material.
