Not open to students at ENG 1200 level or higher.

Rationale for Change:

As a result of our Pathways certification, this course's learning outcomes include more than just listening and speaking but also basic human communication, language and nonverbal communication.

We also removed the English 91/92/93 statement since we believe that this series of courses will be changing for the Fall 2018 semester.
