The main themes of Western civilization from the Middle Ages to the 18<sup>th</sup> century. The nature of medieval society, birth of modern capitalism, expansion of Europe, the Renaissance, religious revolution of the 16<sup>th</sup> century, emergence of modern science, and the Age of Reason.

HIS 5200-

Europe in the Middle Ages: Politics, Culture and Society

Study of the ideas, institutions, and cultures of European Civilization from Late Antiquity through the Middle Ages and Early Modern Period. Topics surveyed include the political and spiritual transformation of the Roman Empire; Medieval monarchy, religion, commerce, and everyday intellectual life; and the transition into the Early Modern period marked by the Renaissance, the Reformation, and commercial exploration.

#### **Rationale**

New title and description better align with developments in the discipline and manner in which the course is taught.
