Change in Degree Requirements (A.S. Theatre Arts)

The Department of Communications & Performing Arts is proposing a change in the options for program electives within the A.S. Theatre Arts Degree.

Please add the following courses to the list of viable program electives, from which theatre arts students must complete 6 credits:

- THA 4000: Performance Practicum
- THA 4200: Advanced Theatre Practicum

Rationale for Change:

THA 4000 is an existing, repeatable course that student may take up to two times to satisfy the practicum requirements for the degree. Adding the course to the list of program electives will not only allow students to receive credit for work on productions after the practicum requirements have been met, but will also aid students in completing the program elective requirements for the degree.

THA 4200 is a new course and needs to be added as an option toward completing the program elective requirements for the degree.
