The Department of Communications and Performing Arts is proposing the following changes for the A.S. in Theatre Arts Degree:

- 1. Change in Course Title/Description for THA 4000
- 2. Change in Course Title/Description for THA 4100
- 3. Deletion of Program Electives for Theatre Arts Degree
- 4. Change in Course Title for THA 5000
- 5. Change in Course Description for THA 5100
- 6. Change in Course Description for THA 5800
- 7. New Course Proposal for THA 4001
- 8. New Course Proposal for THA 4101
- 9. Addition of note

#### **Rationale for Changes:**

The Theatre Arts Program is in the midst of a multi-semester process of reviewing all course titles, descriptions, syllabi and learning outcomes in preparation for an upcoming programmatic area review. The changes in course titles and descriptions have been made to better reflect course content and sequencing.

The change in program electives is in response to the recent addition of newly developed theatre classes (THA 4200, 4300, 4400 and 4700), eliminating the need for non-theatre classes (SPE 2700, 2900, and ART 3300) within the list of program electives.

The changes regarding THA 4000 and 4100, as well as the addition of THA 4001 and THA 4101, are to address issues related to the need for students to take the course multiple times in accordance with degree requirement. In order to satisfy the requirements of the theatre arts major, students must take a combination of THA 4000/4100 three times in order to graduate. The above changes will help students to achieve this in the following ways:

- The addition of "Series" to the course titles for THA 4000/4100 outline the need for the course to be taken multiple times.
- Students will be able to repeat THA 4000/4100 up to 5 times in order to meet both the program elective and practicum requirements of the A.S in Theatre Arts degree.
- Students will be able to take two practicum sections in one semester (with departmental permission) in the event that they need to do so in order to graduate on time (THA 4001/4101).
- In order to ensure that students do not self-enroll in THA 4001 or THA 4101 (which are by departmental permission only), a note will be placed in the course of study to advise students accordingly: "THA 4001 (Performance Practicum) and THA 4101 (Production Practicum) are for students who are out of sequence in their Practicums and MUST take two of the SAME Practicums in the SAME semester in order to meet the requirements of the degree. Consultation with the Communications and Performing Arts Department is required to enroll in these courses. These courses are equivalent to THA 4000 and THA 4100."
