Rationale for Change:

(1) The change in course name to U.S. is consistent with current practices. (2) Three courses were created since the development of the Philosophy Concentration. As students can take any three Philosophy courses to fulfill the concentration, streamlining the concentration structure does not limit students if additional Philosophy courses are added at another time.
