Department of Health, Physical Education, and Recreation is proposing a change in corequisite for COH 1600 – Patient Engagement Techniques in Community Health

Rationale for Change:

Patient Engagement Techniques in Community Health (COH 1600) is being proposed as part of a new concentration, Coordinated Health Care, under the AS Community Health. These two courses, COH 1600 and HPE 1200, are packaged as a Health Coaching microcredential, which is recognized by various health care industry leaders in New York City, such as Local 1199SEIU, New York Alliance for Careers in Healthcare, and Community Care of Brooklyn. In turn, it would guarantee that these two courses are taken together as the material covered in both complement and build on each other. This also ensures appropriate course sequencing for the new concentration.
