Rationale for Change:

Past enrollment trends have shown that nonmajors are interested in enrolling and are often successful in computer-based graphic design classes like Art 49, an animation concentration course, but may not enroll due to the listed prerequisite. While it is recommended that Graphic Design and Illustration majors take Art 55 first as part of their Graphic Design and Illustration education, including permissions in the prerequisite section would also allow motivated nonmajors to take this class. This class will also be a recommended elective by the Media program to their students, as the concepts covered are applicable to video/filmmaking as well.
