Subject: Minor Degree Changes in Business Administration and Accounting

Under our new Business Administration and Accounting A.S. degree requirements, a not-insignificant number of students are misconstruing the strong recommendation to take ECO 1200 and ECO 1300 within the Pathways flexible core requirement. This has led to students taking various courses in that area that do not transfer well when they transfer to 4-year institutions.

As such, we are submitting a description change that will help clarify the need to take ECO 1200 & 1300 in both degrees.

In addition, we are submitting a request to eliminate the TAH 500 optional course in Business Administration, since the customer service option no longer exists.

In conversations with Brooklyn College, it has come to my attention that Brooklyn College requires Phil 3314 (Moral Issues in Business) for all of its BBA degree areas. The equivalent course at Kingsborough Community College is PHI 6800. We submitted a changed (with support from the Chair of History, Philosophy, and Political Science) for the Business Administration degree to include a statement under Flexible Core, Group A, World Cultures and Global Issues recommending this course if planning to transfer to Brooklyn's BBA.

We would appreciate your including these changes on the upcoming curriculum committee agenda.

Changes to the A.S. in Business Administration

These changes will help clarify the need to take ECO 1200 & 1300 and eliminates the TAH 500 optional course, since the customer service option no longer exists.

- In Flexible Core, include "It is recommended that students planning to transfer to Brooklyn College's BBA program take PHIL 3314 to satisfy the Pathways Flexible Core Group A requirement.
- 2. In Flexible Core, add asterisks to ECO 1200 & 1300 to indicate note.
- 3. In Department options list, delete "or" after ECO 14 listing.
- 4. Also in Department options list, delete TAH 500 course from options.
- 5. In NOTE, delete first note about Customer Service.
- 6. Also in NOTE, add new note:

"*It is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED that students take both ECO 1200 and ECO 1300 to satisfy the Pathways Flexible Core courses. However, if neither course is used within the Pathways Flexible Core, both must be taken within the major and no optional courses will be required."
