The Department of HPER is proposing a change in Course Description and Title for RPE-3200

FROM:

RPE 32 Organization and Administration of Recreation Programs 3 credit(s) 3 hrs. Hours

Underlying principles for effective recreation programming, considers operation of recreation facilities, including budget, public relations, records, reports, equipment and evaluation.

TO:

**RPE 32 Organization and Administration of Recreation, Physical Education, and Sport Management
3 credit(s) 3 hrs. Hours**

Examine the principles of organization and administration of recreation, physical education, sport programs and facilities. Focuses on developing effective programming: a mission statement/goals/objectives, needs assessment, facility planning, program implementation, and evaluation. Learn effective communication, budget, public relations, risk management/safety, and personnel/supervision issues. Requirement to attend two college wide events and evaluate each one as an operations manager.

Rationale for Change:

The new description and title change reflects the current content of the course and allows the course to better articulate with senior colleges.

Department of Health, Physical Education, and Recreation is proposing a change in prerequisite for RPE 3200 – Organization and Administration of Recreation Programs

FROM:

Prerequisite(s): RPE 1100, RPE 1200, ~~RPE 1600~~, and RPE 3100. For Program Majors only.

Prerequisite(s)/Corequisite(s): RPE 9152

TO:

Prerequisite(s): RPE 1100, RPE 1200, and RPE 3100. **RPE 3100 Not required for Sports Management students**

Prerequisite(s)/Corequisite(s): RPE 9152

Rationale for Change:

This addresses the hidden credits of RPE 3100 in the Sports Management Concentration. For this concentration, RPE 3100, Therapeutic Recreation for Individuals with Disabilities I, is not required for enrollment in RPE 3200, Organization and Administration of Recreation Programs. This change also ensures that students complete the courses in the required sequence. RPE 1600, Folk and Square Dance Teaching and Techniques, is no longer a requirement of the A.S. in Physical Education, Recreation, and Recreation Therapy and should be removed as a prerequisite
