The Department of Allied Health, Mental Health and Human Services is proposing a degree change for the A.A.S. Physical Therapist Assistant.

Change:

1. Under Required Core, Mathematical and Quantitative Reasoning (MQR) the **addition** of MAT 2010 – Integrated Statistics.

Rationale for Change:

The addition of MAT 2010 as an option for students is required as the developmental pathway of MAT M100 to MAT M200 to MAT R300 that leads to MAT 2000 will no longer be offered due to the CUNY mandate for removal of developmental education effective Fall 2022. The update to the degree requirements reflects this pathway.
