Rationale for Changes:

After consultation with advisors from the Education & Justice Academy, we were advised to re-sequence the courses in the Birth-2nd Grade concentration to have students take their Life & Physical Sciences course during the semester rather than the module due to potential scheduling conflicts. We want our students to take our EDC 2800 during the same semester as the Life & Physical Sciences course for content area learning. Therefore, we would like to move the EDC 2800 to the second semester along with the Life & Physical Sciences course.
