To be considered for the Rob Pero Memorial Scholarship, in addition to the recommendation letter and your transcript, you must submit a typed essay (at least 250 words or longer), along with this application, by May 17, 2024. It must describe, as specifically as possible, the following (you must number each answer in your essay):

- 1. tell us something about yourself, not included elsewhere in the essay, that you would like us to know.
- 2. if you had to pick out one thing that was most important to you, what would that be?
- 3. how did the pandemic and online learning affect your introduction to high school and the rest of your high school career?
- 4. what's the most important thing you have learned **from each** of the College Now courses you have taken (be specific)?
- 5. what has the College Now experience meant to you, including its impact on your high school academic career?
- 6. what are your future academic and career goals and plans?
- 7. how will this scholarship help you achieve your goals?

The essay must be submitted along with your application, high school transcript and a letter of recommendation to your school's College Now Program Coordinator or other school designated person. They will assemble everything for submission to the College Now Scholarship Committee.
