QUALIFICATIONS: A baccalaureate or graduate degree (master's degree preferred) in Behavioral and Social Sciences (Anthropology, History, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology). A minimum of three years teaching experience is preferred.
DUTIES: To teach a 3 credit, 3- hour college level course to junior and/or senior students at this high school entitled CRJ 63: Introduction to Criminal Justice .
DESCRIPTION: The course introduces students to the three agencies that comprise the criminal justice system: police, courts and corrections. Particular attention is given to: (1) the process of justice. i.e., investigation, arrest, booking, initial appearance, probable cause hearing, grand jurt, indictment, arraignment and plea, plea bargain or jury trail, sentencing hearing, incarceration, and release, and (2) the due process rights of defendants as delineated in the Bill of Rights and the Fourteenth Amendment.
