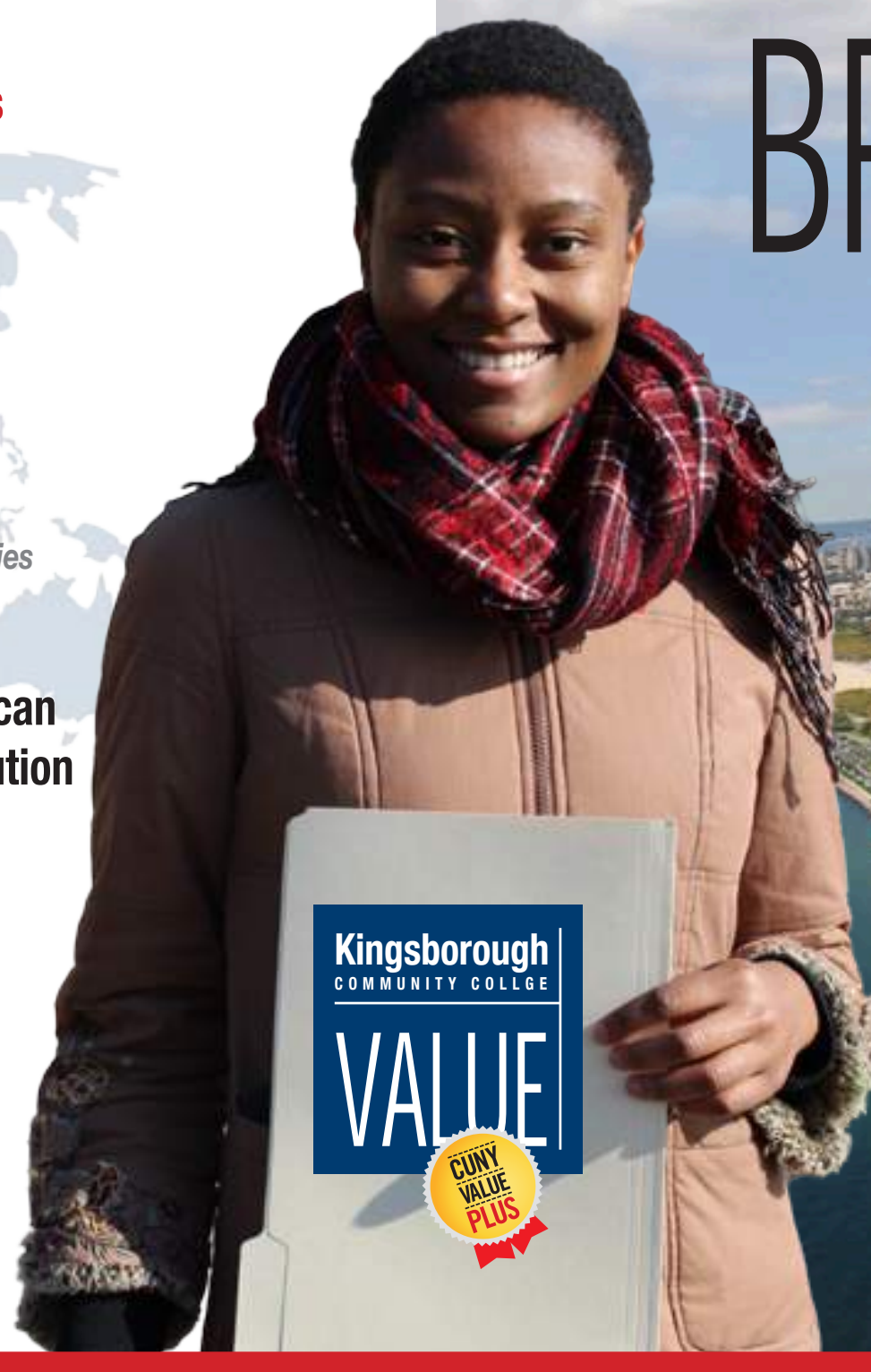


• Kingsborough students represent **142 countries** and speak **73 different languages**



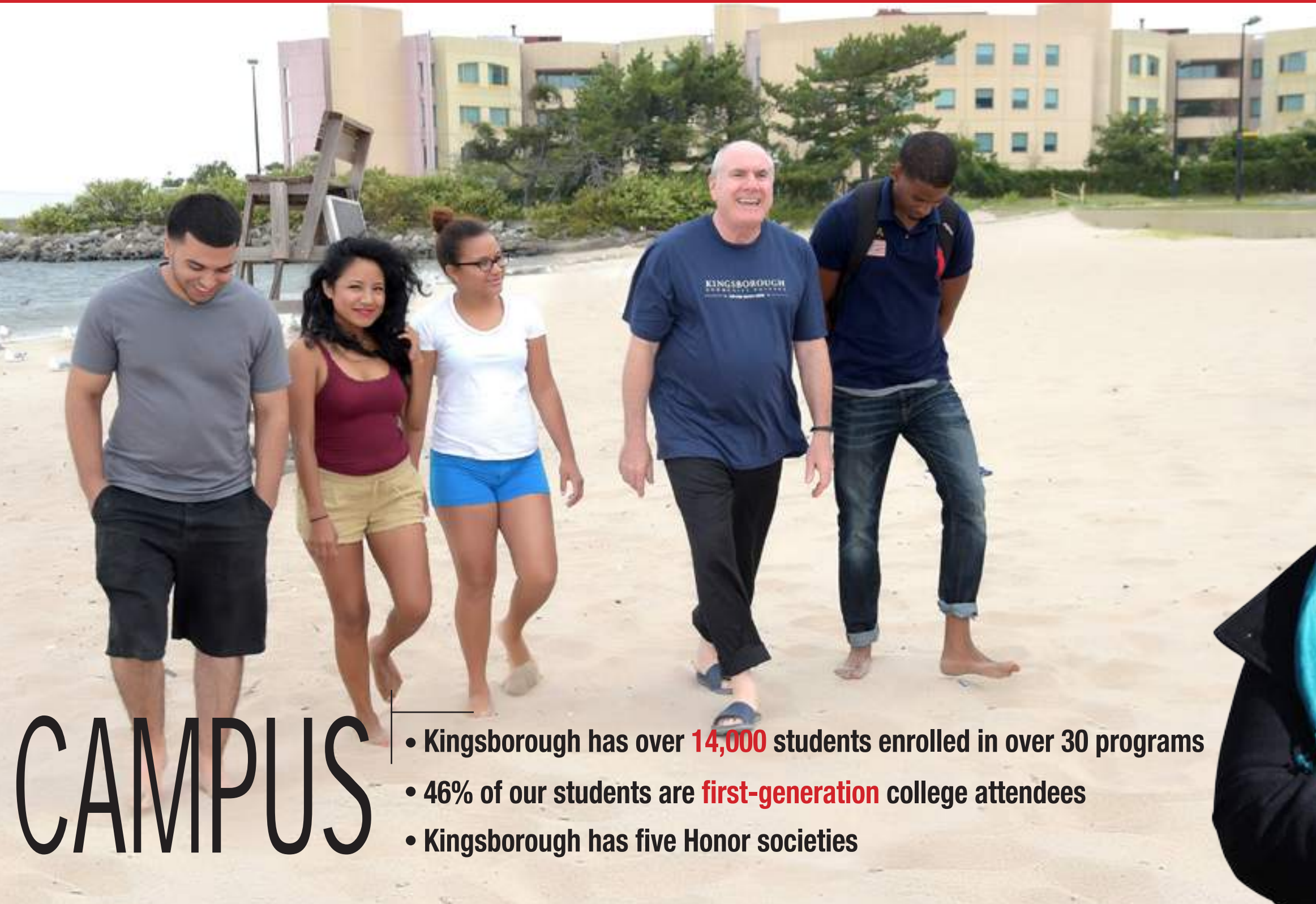

## BROOKLYN

- Kingsborough is the **ONLY** community college in Brooklyn
- Kingsborough was ranked **Top 4 Among Community Colleges** in the Nation (Aspen Institute 2013)
- Kingsborough is the **ONLY** school and community college in New York State to earn **Leader College** distinction (Achieving the Dream 2015)



## CAMPUS

- Kingsborough has over **14,000** students enrolled in over 30 programs
- 46% of our students are **first-generation** college attendees
- Kingsborough has five Honor societies

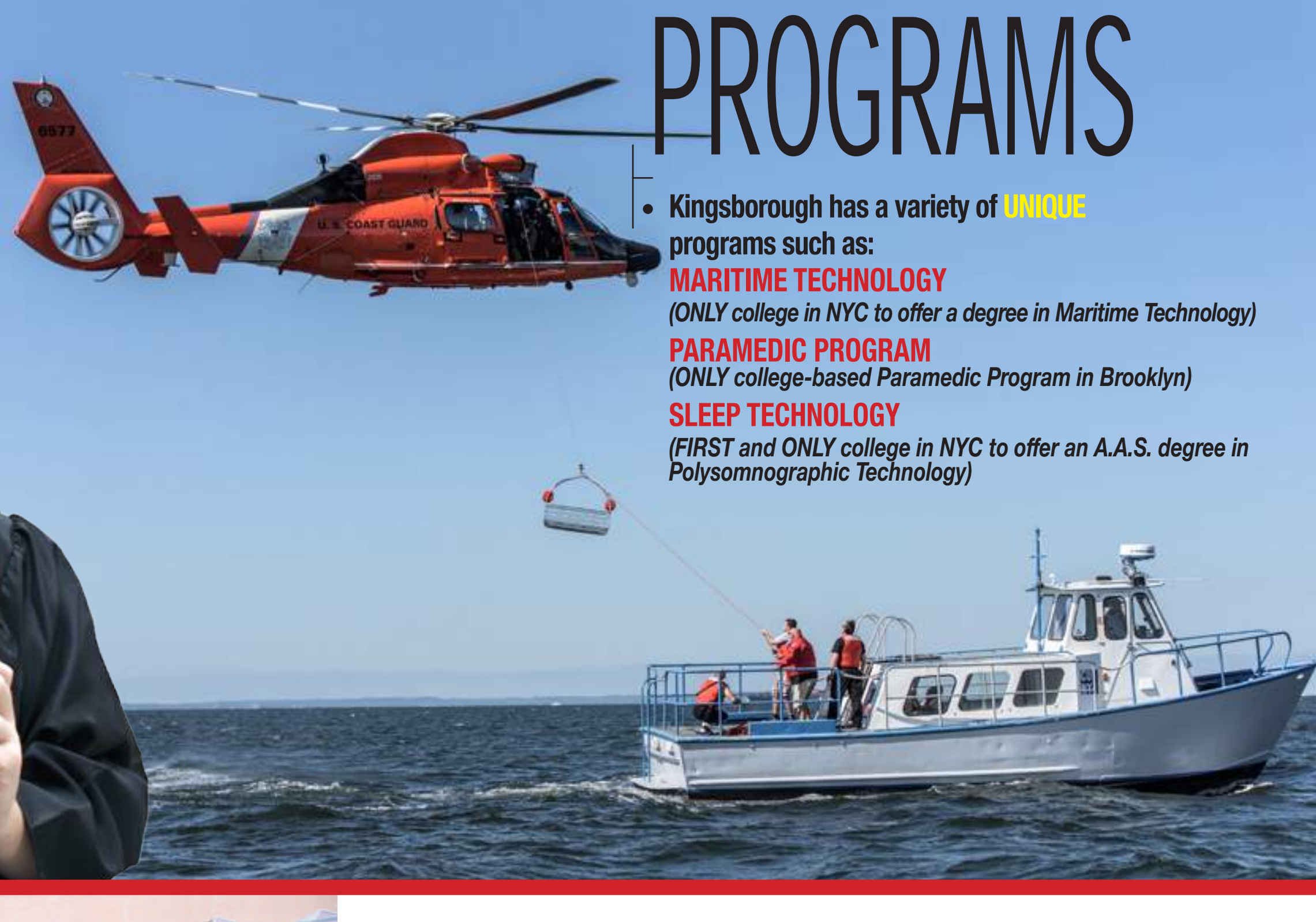
## GLOBAL CITIZENSHIP

- Kingsborough offers students the opportunity to participate in the **Salzburg Global Seminar** each year
- Kingsborough students learn about global citizenship through the **most active Student World Assembly** chapter in the nation



## SMART CHOICE

- Kingsborough ranks **No. 14** among community colleges nationwide for **associate degrees awarded to minority graduates** (College Community Week Top 100 Rankings, 2015)
- The unique "12/6" academic calendar allows students to take **up to 24 credits** over two sessions **at no additional cost**, creating the possibility of graduating in less than two years
- More than 65% of Kingsborough's full-time students attend **tuition-free**



## PROGRAMS

- Kingsborough has a variety of **UNIQUE** programs such as:  
**MARITIME TECHNOLOGY** (ONLY college in NYC to offer a degree in Maritime Technology)  
**PARAMEDIC PROGRAM** (ONLY college-based Paramedic Program in Brooklyn)  
**SLEEP TECHNOLOGY** (FIRST and ONLY college in NYC to offer an A.A.S. degree in Polysomnographic Technology)



## STEM

- Kingsborough's **urban farm** is managed by students, faculty, and staff. The on-campus, quarter-acre site includes approximately 7,000 square feet for cultivation and learning experiences for the entire KCC community. The farm is also an **outdoor STEM lab** for experiential learning where students can get their hands dirty researching local ecosystems, soil, health, and our food system.



## FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- Kingsborough provided over **\$790,000** in scholarships to students last year
- Kingsborough is the **first college in the nation** to host a Single Stop USA office, which has obtained over \$1.5 million in additional benefits and services for qualified students since 2009

- Kingsborough's WKRB radio station was named **"Best Community College Station"** in 2014 by the Intercollegiate Broadcasting System (IBS)

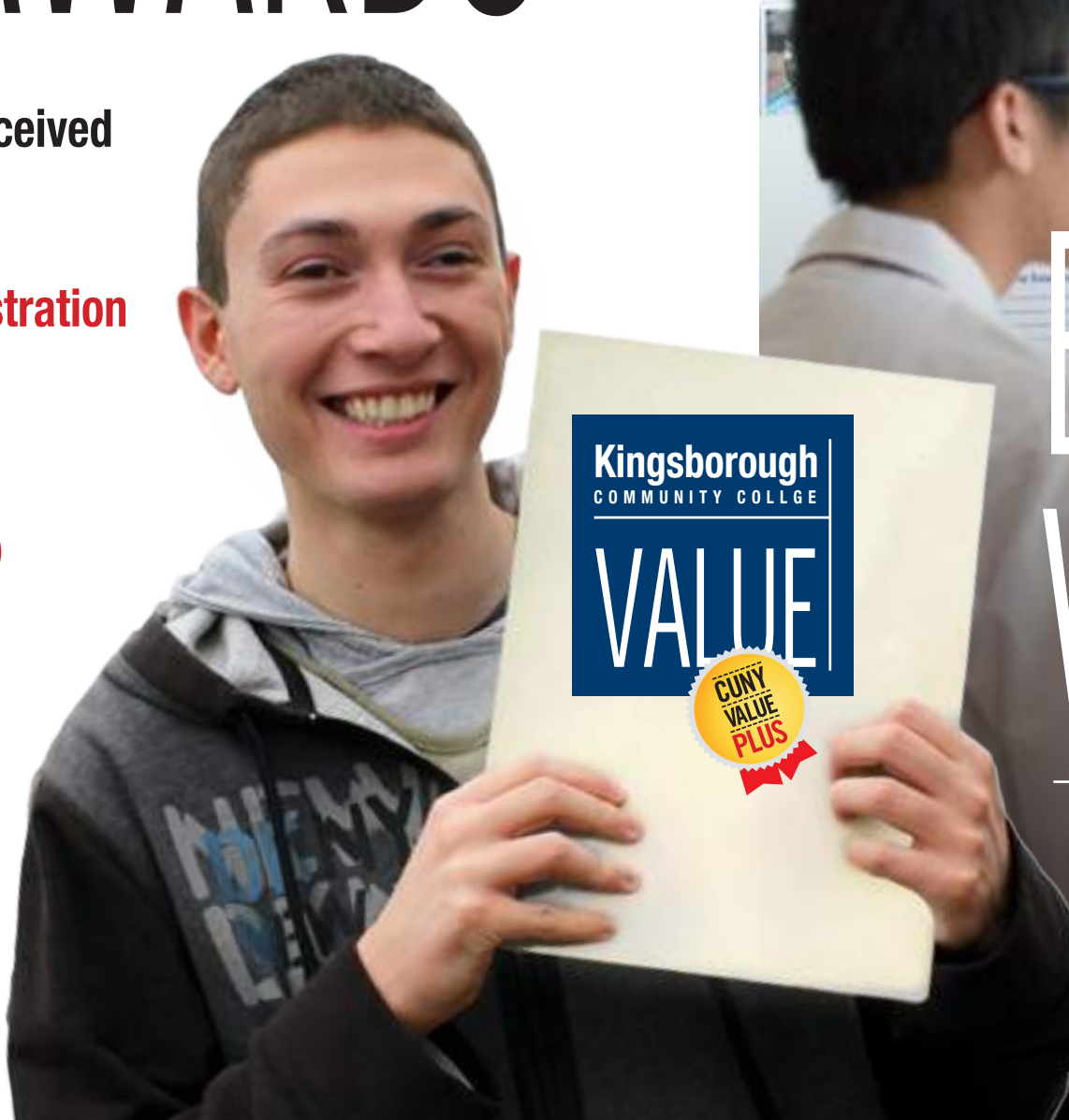
## FACULTY
