

Instructions: Honors Program students and faculty should identify the applicable honors experience below, complete the requisite information, and return the form to honors@kbcc.cuny.edu by the last Friday of the first month of the semester.

Honors Eligibility: All admitted Honors Program students are eligible to complete an HEC or Honors Contract. Honors-eligible students must have i) 3.2 GPA, ii) 12+ cumulative credits, and iii) a B+ or higher in ENG 1200 and/or ENG 2400 to complete an honors experience. Students who do not meet this criteria but wish to complete an honors experience should reach out to the Honors Program at honors@kbcc.cuny.edu.

Honors Learning Outcomes: Honors experiences should emphasize at least one of the learning outcomes drafted by the Honors Program community of faculty, staff, and Honors Liaisons. Please note the learning outcome your honors experience incorporates below:

- **Communication:** Demonstrates effective reading, writing, speaking, listening, and/or non-verbal communication skills,
- Information Literacy: Collect, verify, document, and/or organize information from a variety of attributable sources,
- **Quantitative Reasoning:** Understand and apply mathematical concepts and reasoning and analyze and interpret various types of data,
- Global Socio-Cultural Responsibility: Demonstrate an awareness of civic and social participation and informed decision-making,
- **Critical Thinking:** Demonstrates the skills necessary for analysis, synthesis, evaluation, decisionmaking, critical and creative thinking, and the creative process,
- **Original Work:** Demonstrates comfort in the process of exploration, discovery, tolerance of ambiguity, and the maturity to complete an academic goal.

□ Honors Enrichment Component

Honors Enrichment Component (HEC): Honors Enrichment Components are small-group, collaborative honors experiences for Honors Program and honors-eligible students enrolled in either CUNYfirst designated HEC sections or non-designated sections. HECs <u>require a minimum of 3</u> Honors Program or honors-eligible students. A copy of the completed HEC should be submitted at the end of the semester along with the students' earned grades.

Honors Contract (HC): Honors Contracts are independent honors work completed in consultation with a faculty mentor. Honors Contracts may include research papers, scholarly essays, creative writing, poetry, music compositions, visual presentations and/or portfolios, code, advanced mathematical problems, and other discipline-specific work. A copy of the completed Honors Contract should be submitted at the end of the semester along with the student's grade.

HSPs are reserved for <i>Honors Program - Presidential Scholars</i> , and require students to have a 3.5 GPA or higher and be on a path to complete 18+ Honors Program credits. All HSPs must involve a minimum 9+ hours of documented service hours.
