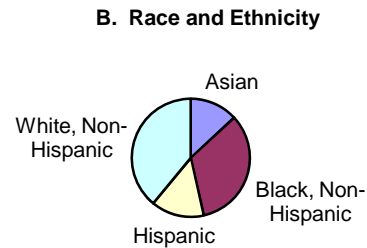

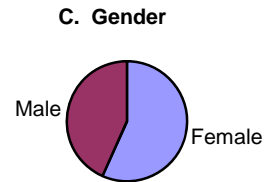

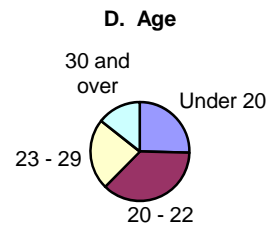

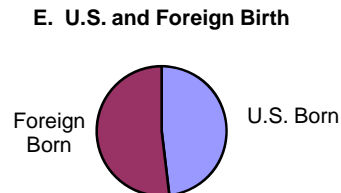

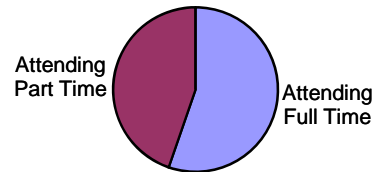

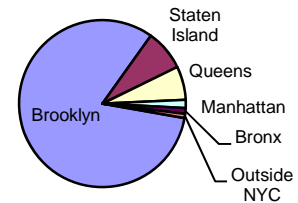

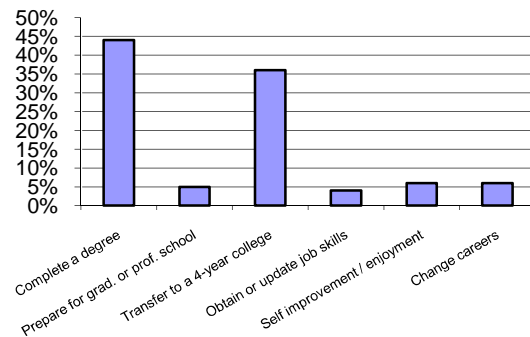

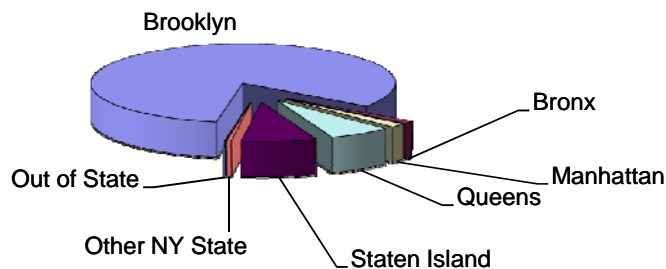


M. New Degree Student Distribution

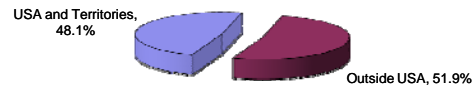

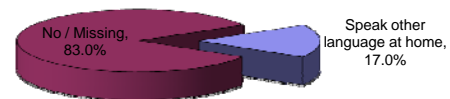

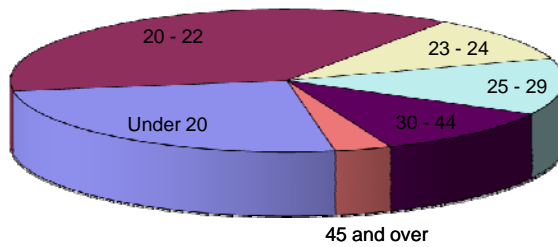

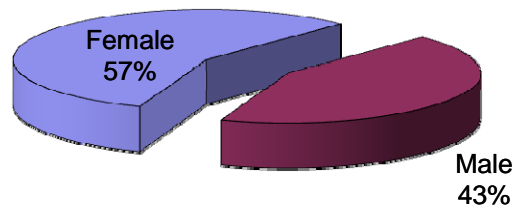

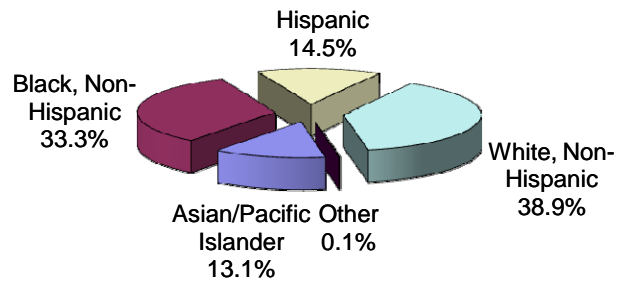

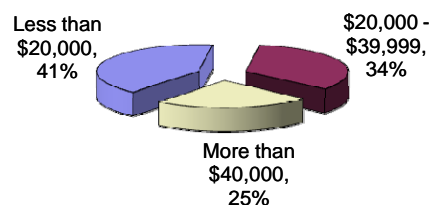

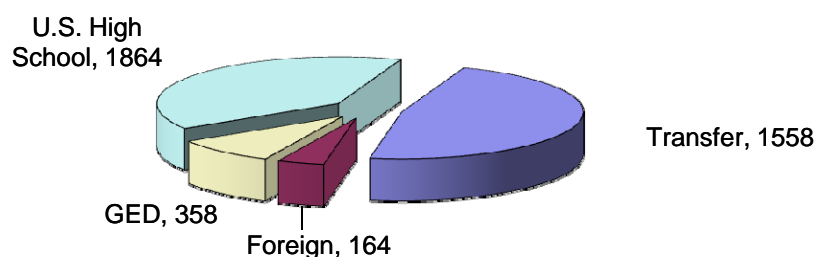

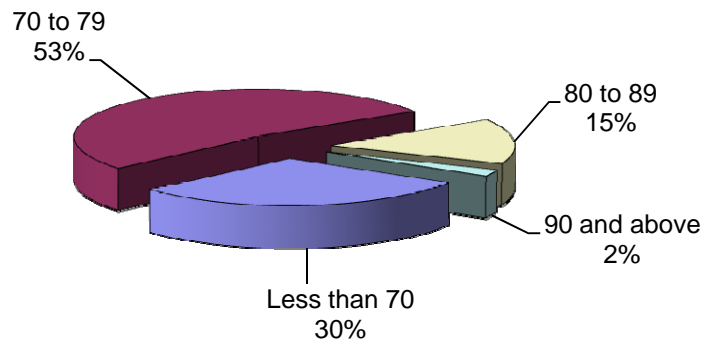

Fall 2008 Freshmen - High School Averages



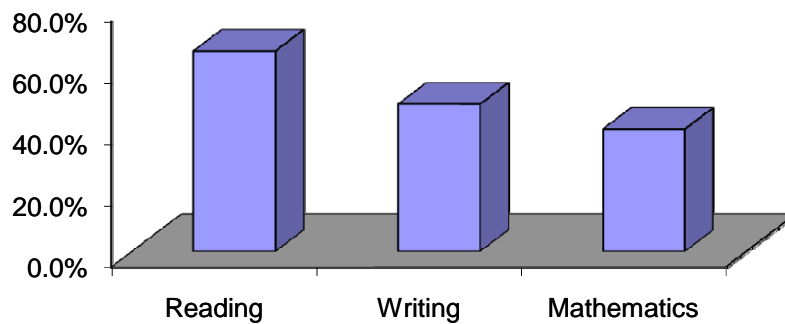

 Freshmen Passing**



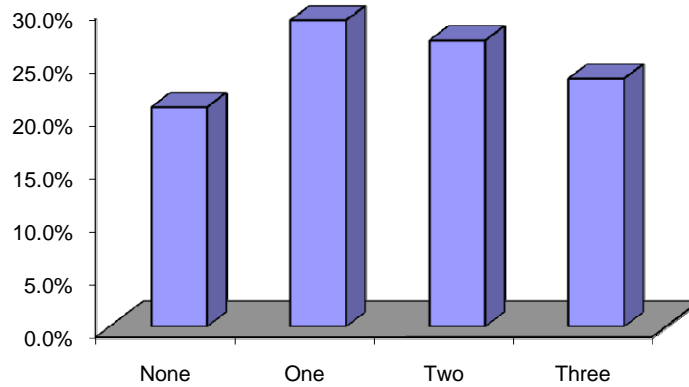

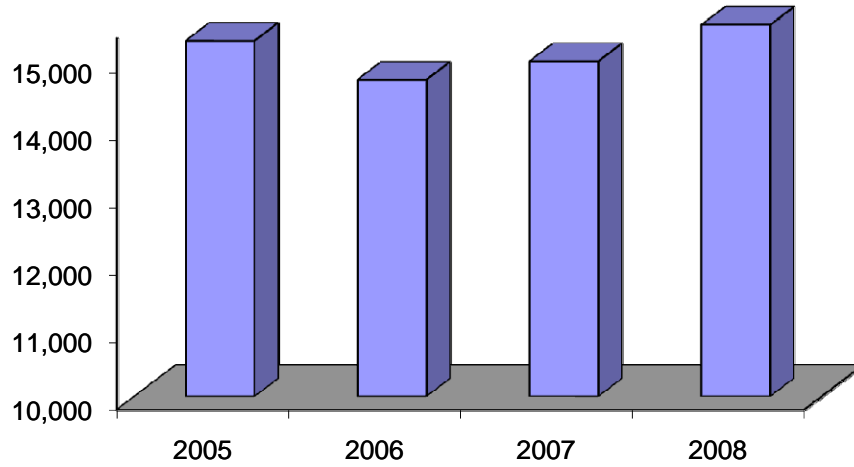

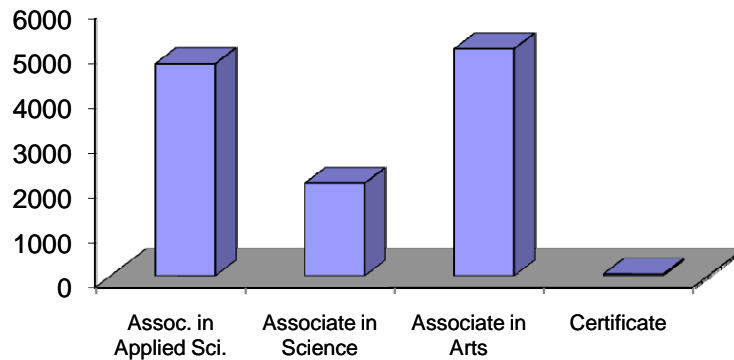

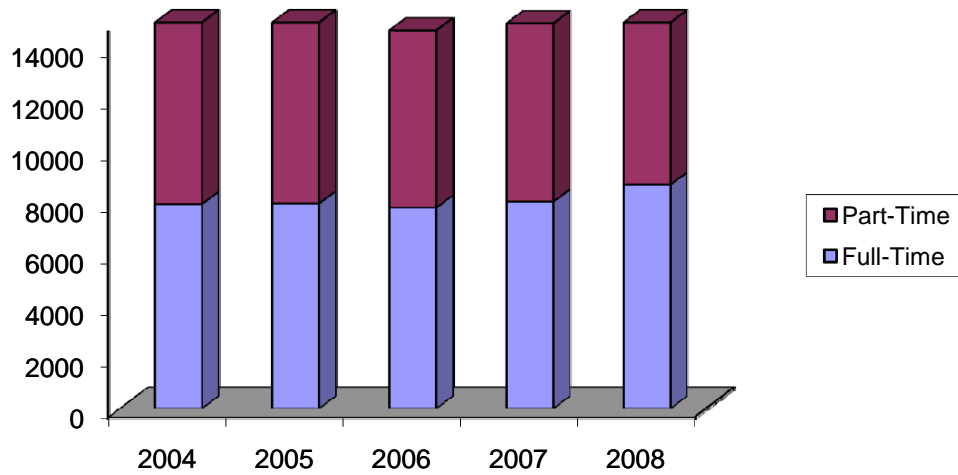

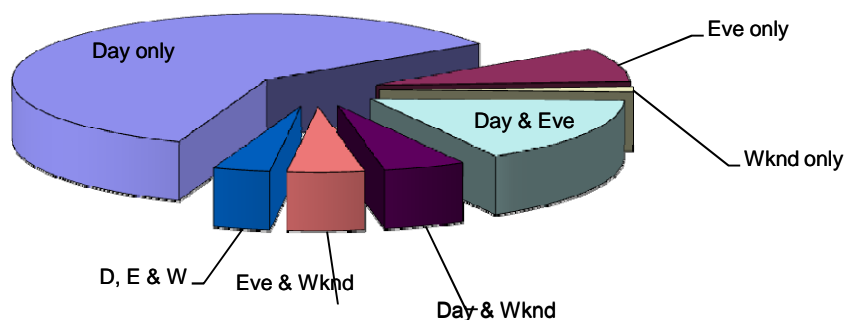

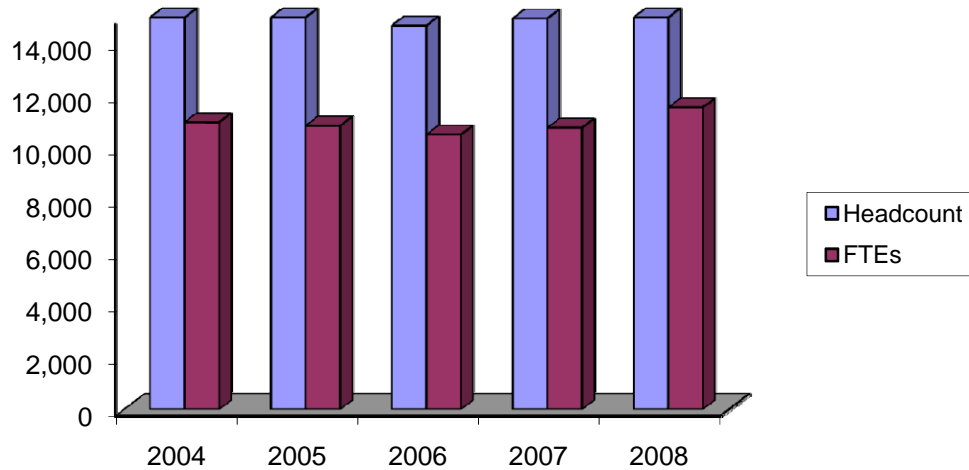

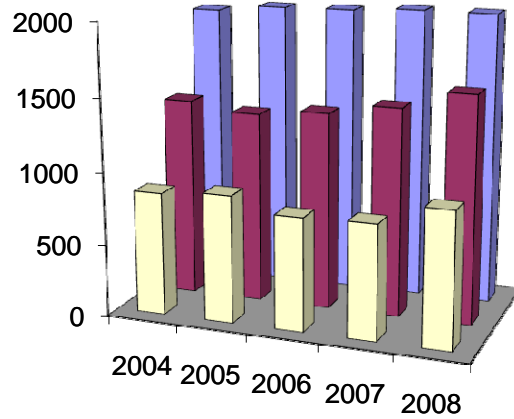

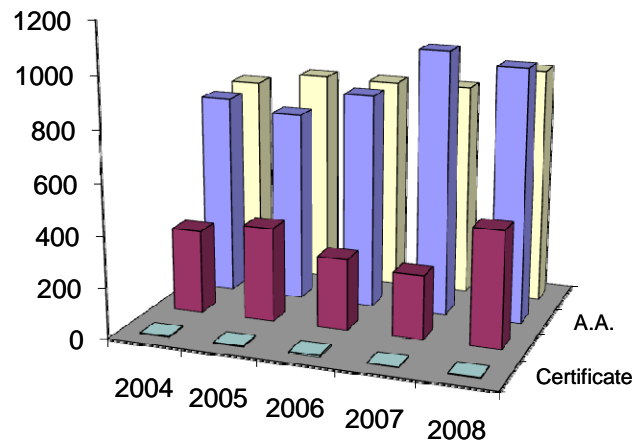
New Degree-Seeking Students Fall 2004 to Fall 2008

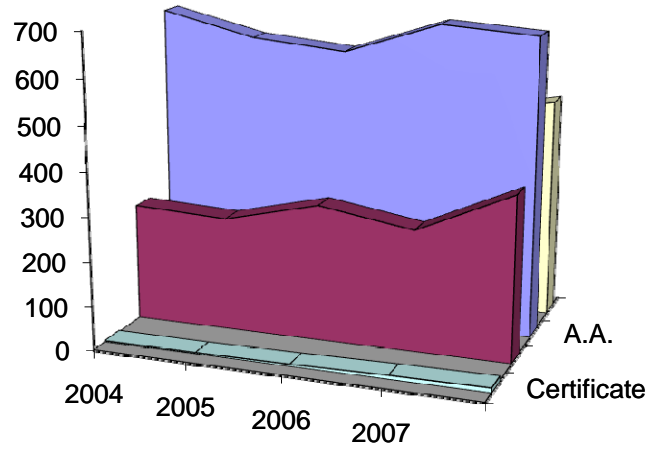

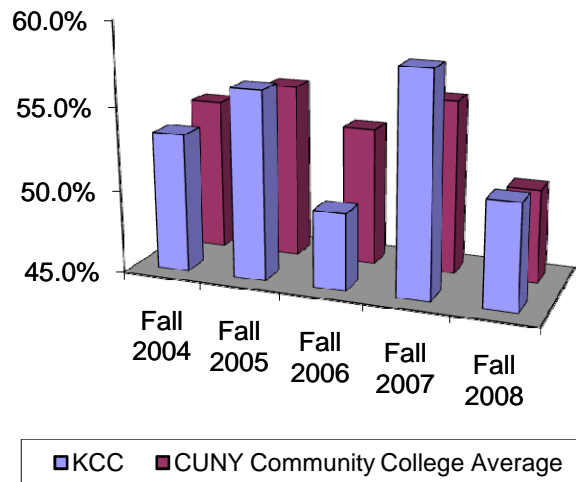

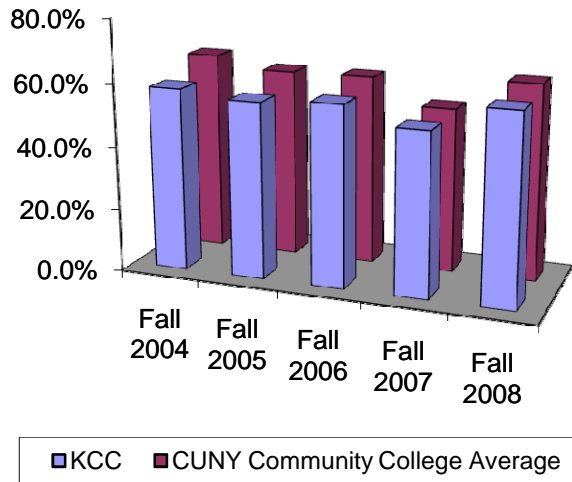
Pass Rates on Exit From Remediation Writing

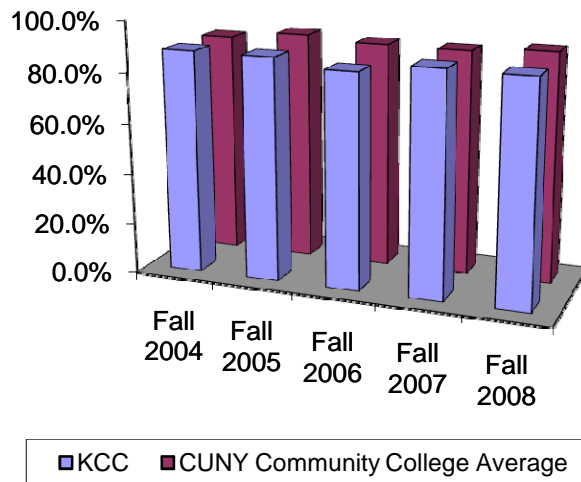
Pass Rates on Exit From Remediation Mathematics

Pass Rates on the CUNY Proficiency Exam

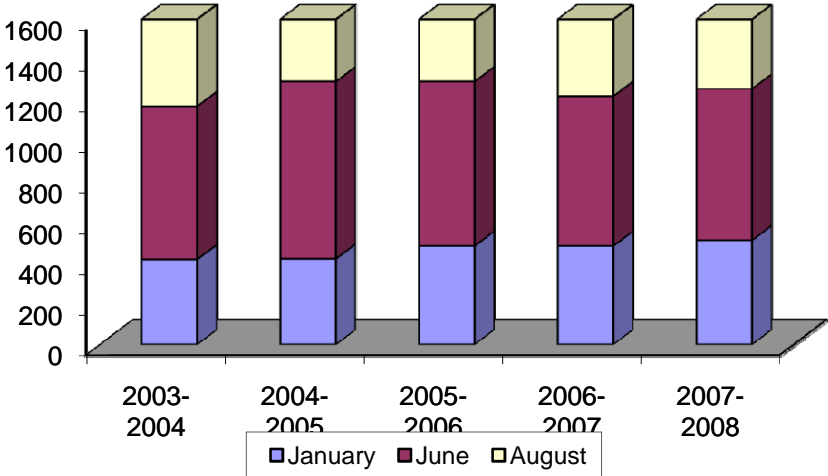

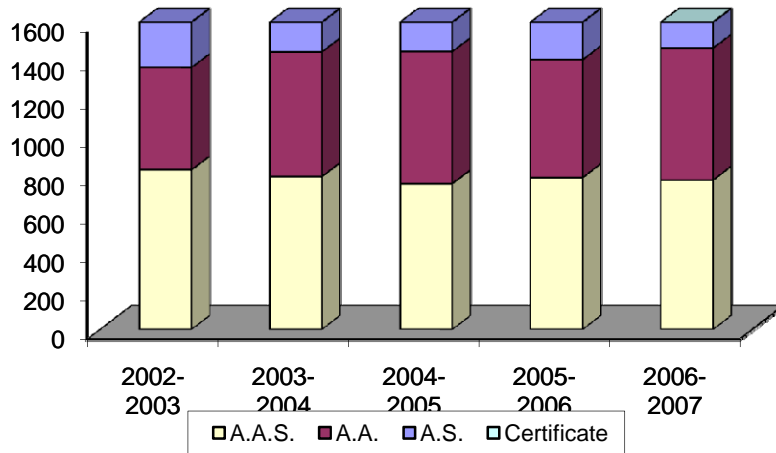

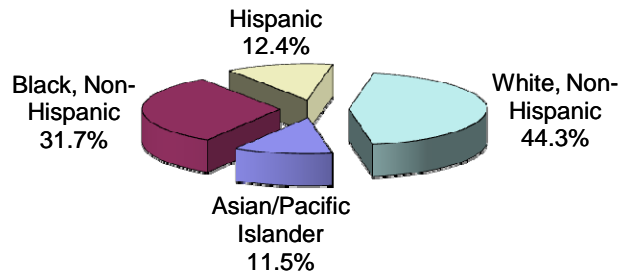
Degrees and Certificates Awarded By Gender 2003-2004 to 2007-2008

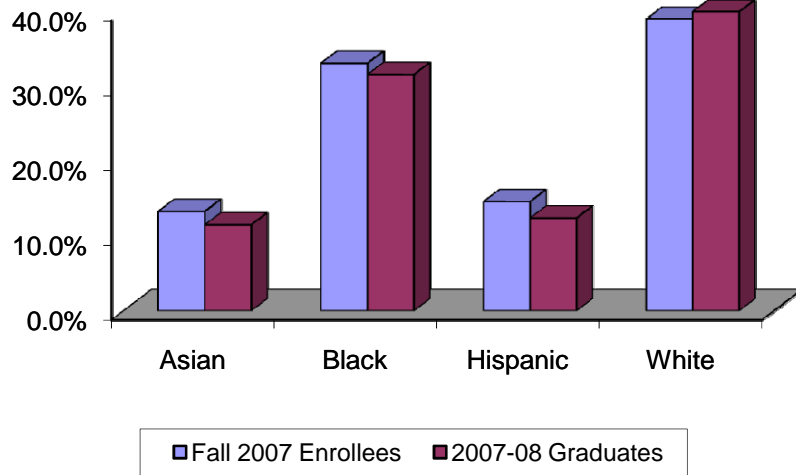

Comparative Distributions of Graduates and Enrollees By Ethnicity 2007-2008

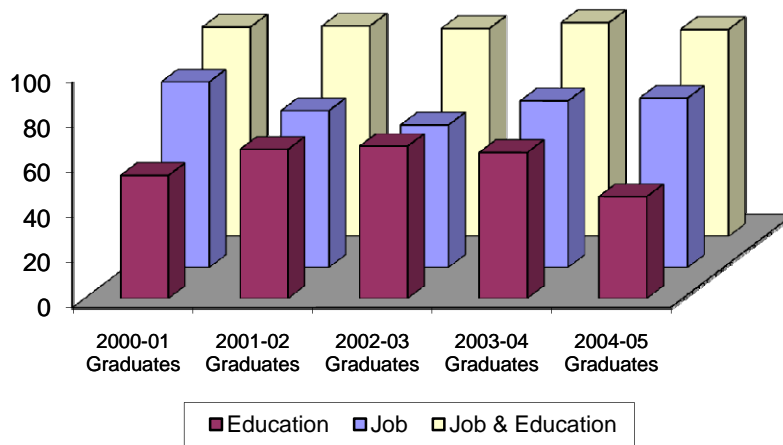

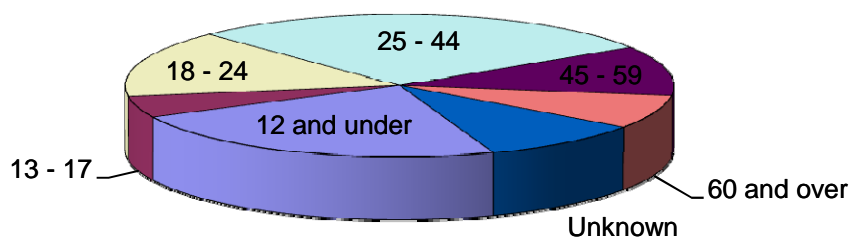

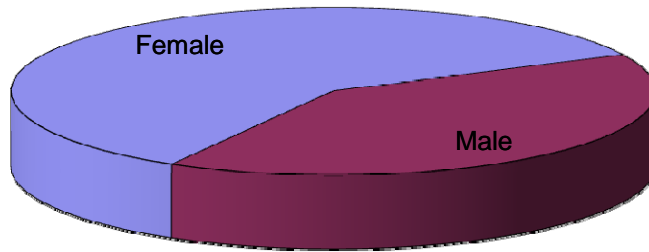
2008 - 2009 ACE Enrollments Age Distribution

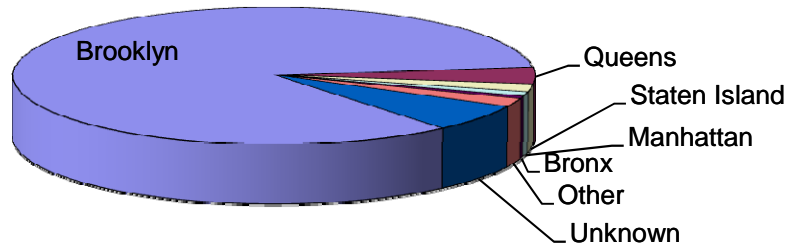
2008 - 2009 ACE Enrollments Gender Distribution

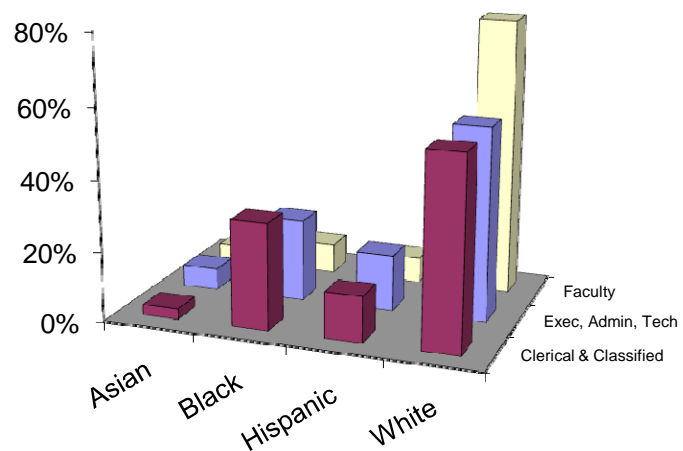

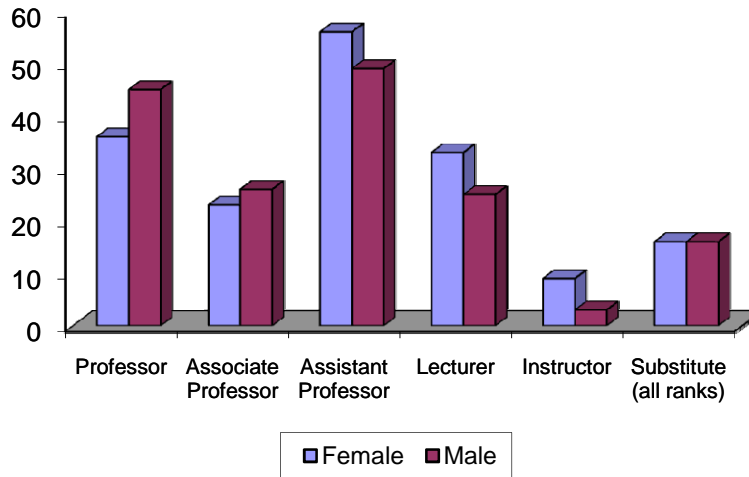

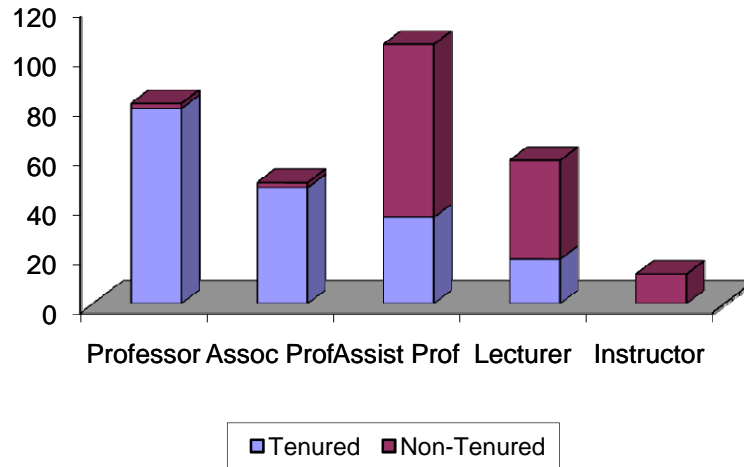
