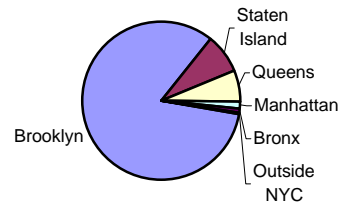

J. Full- or Part-Time Status



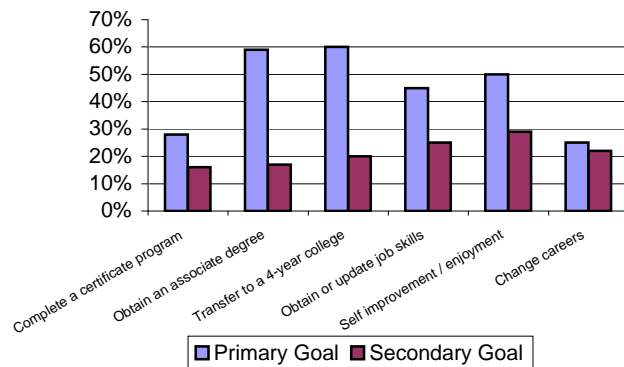

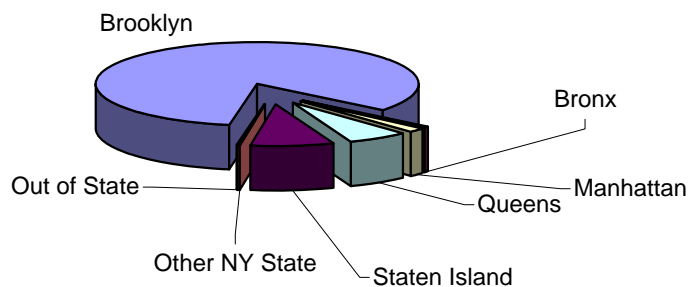


M. New Degree Student Distribution

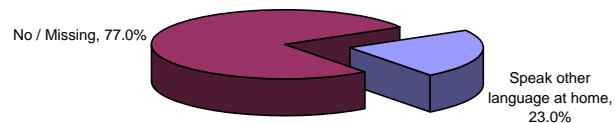

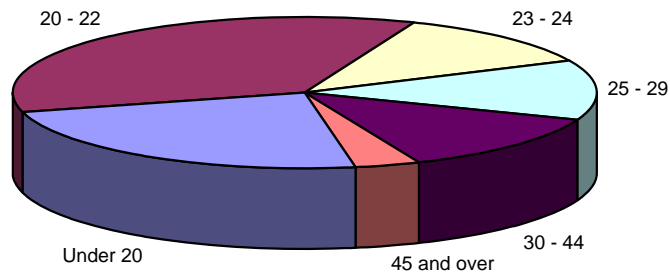

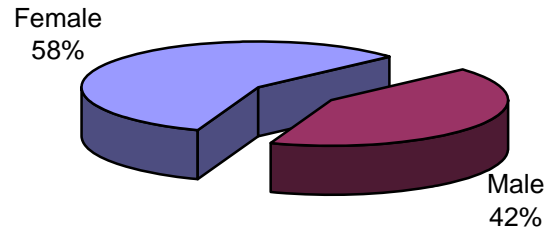

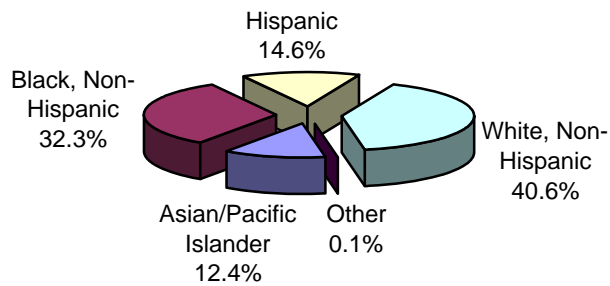

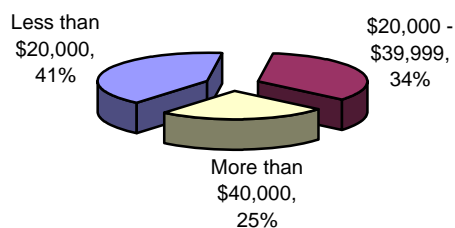

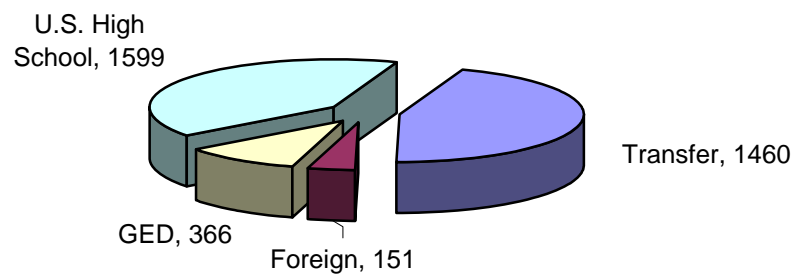

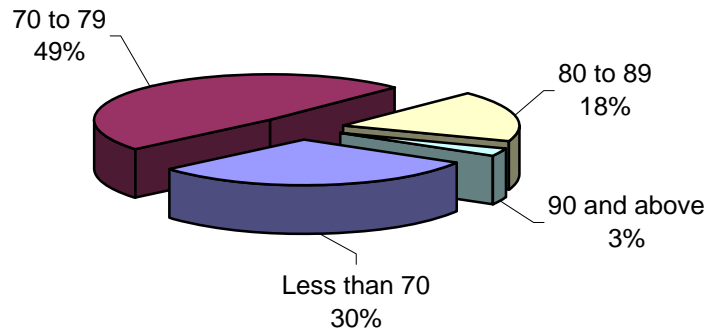

 Freshmen Passing**



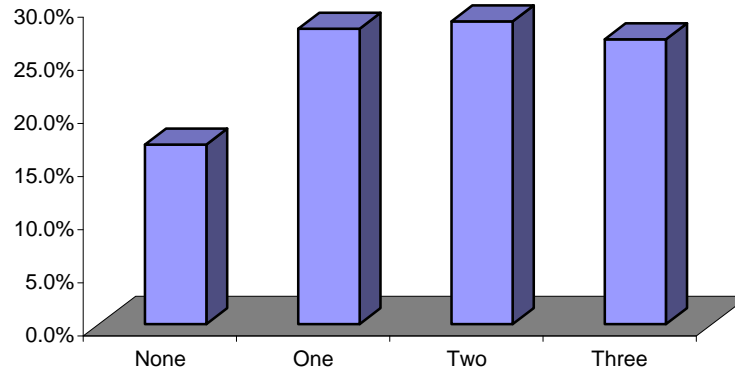

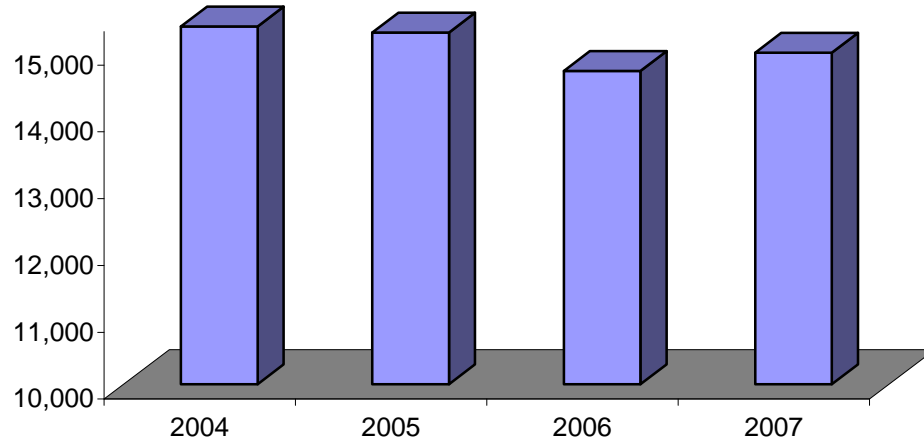

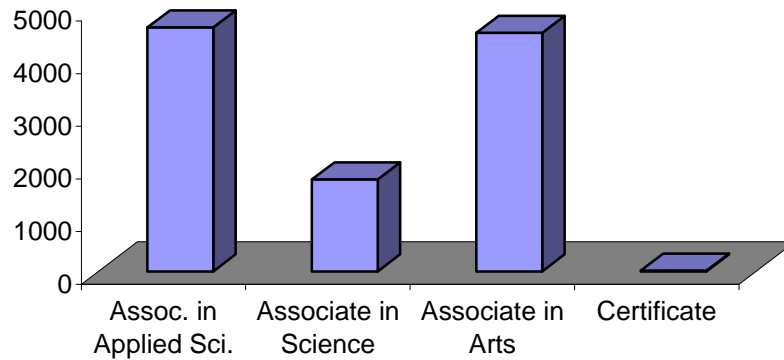

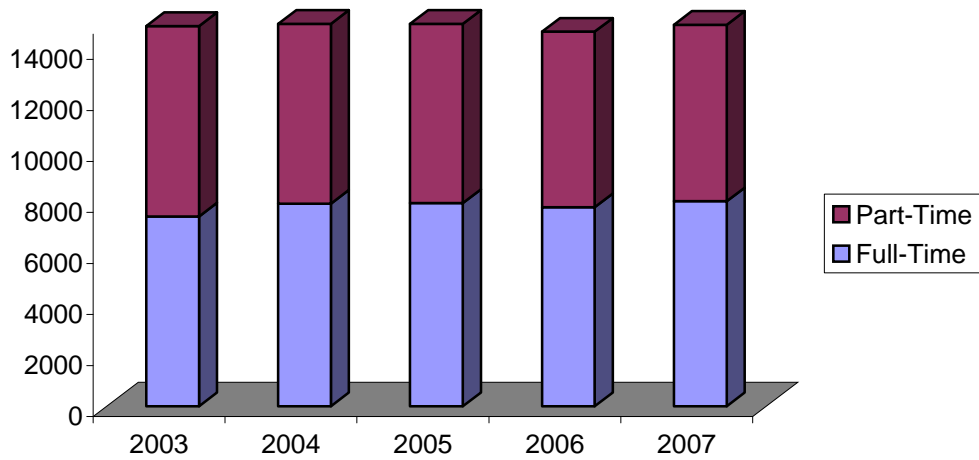

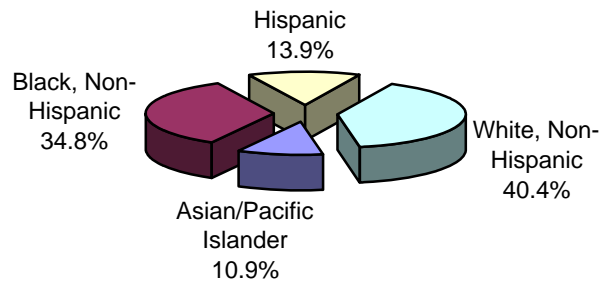
# Degrees and Certificates Awarded By Gender 2002-2003 to 2006-2007

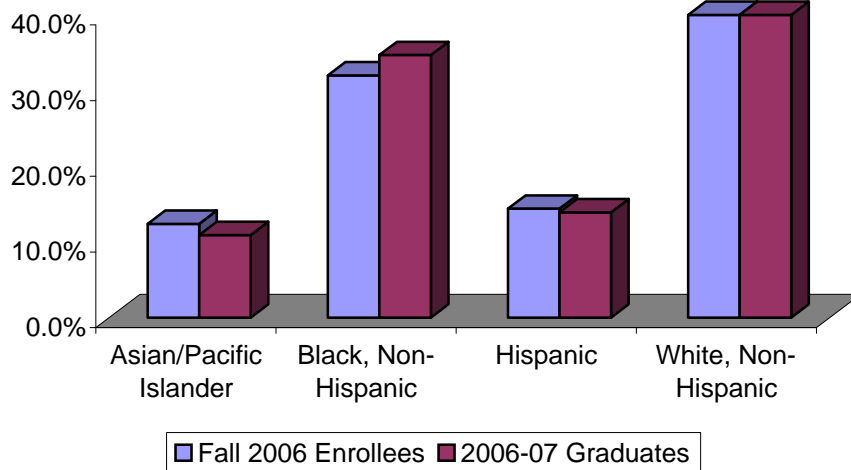

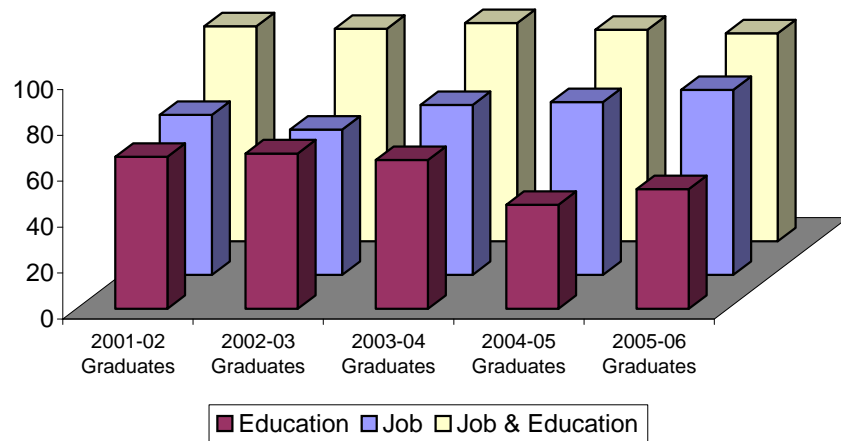

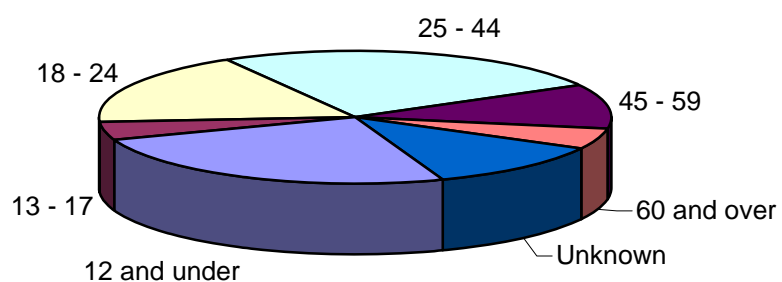

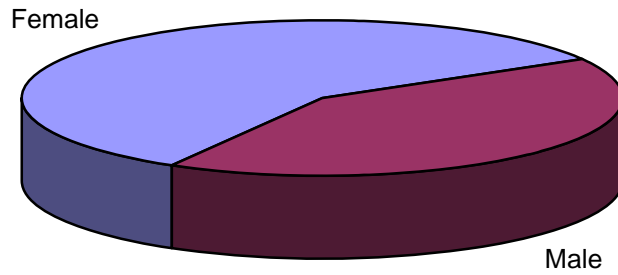
**2007 - 2008 ACE Enrollments Age Distribution**

**2007 - 2008 ACE Enrollments Gender Distribution**

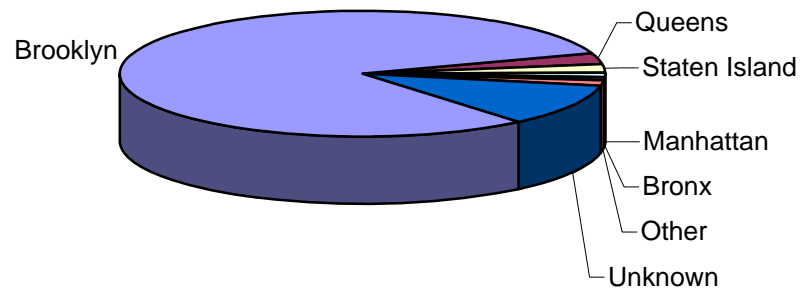

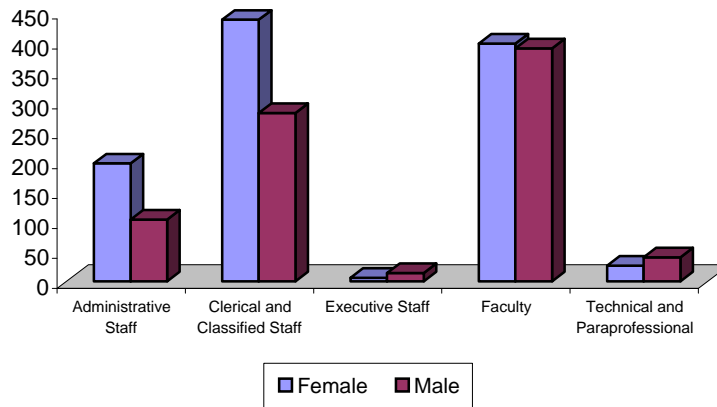

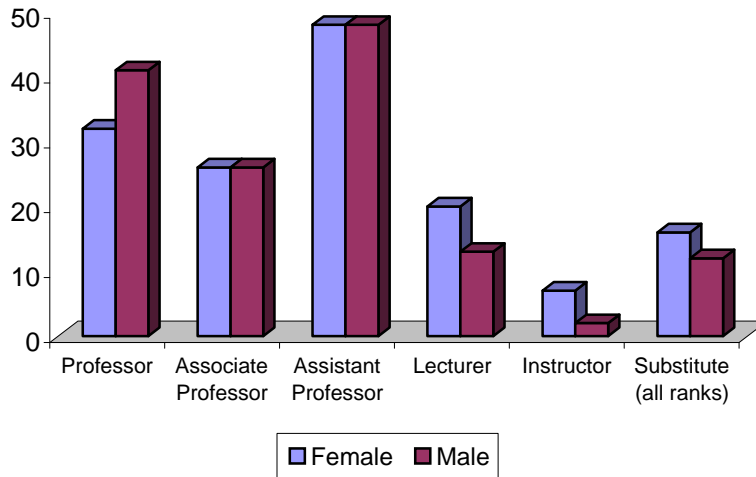

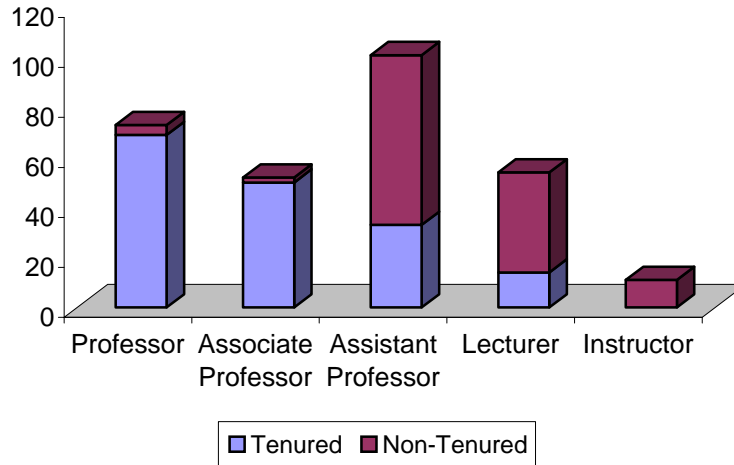
