



Does the student speak another language at home? (Degree students only)





Gender Fall 2003 to Fall 2007









Basic Skills Needs First-Time Freshmen Fall 2003 to Fall 2007



Basic Skills Test Performance First-Time Freshmen Fall 2003 to Fall 2007








Credit Students By Degree Type Fall 2003 to Fall 2007

Credit Students By Full-time and Part Time Status Fall 2003 to Fall 2007








New Degree-Seeking Students Fall 2003 to Fall 2007










Continuing Education Annual Enrollments By Gender Fall 2007 - Summer 2008

Continuing Education Annual Enrollments By Borough of Residence Fall 2007 - Summer 2008





Full Time and Part Time Employment, Job Category and Gender Fall 2007








