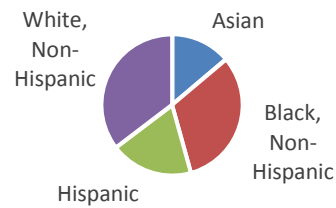

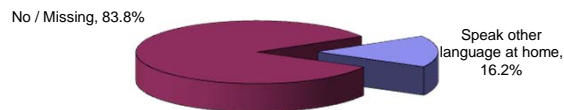

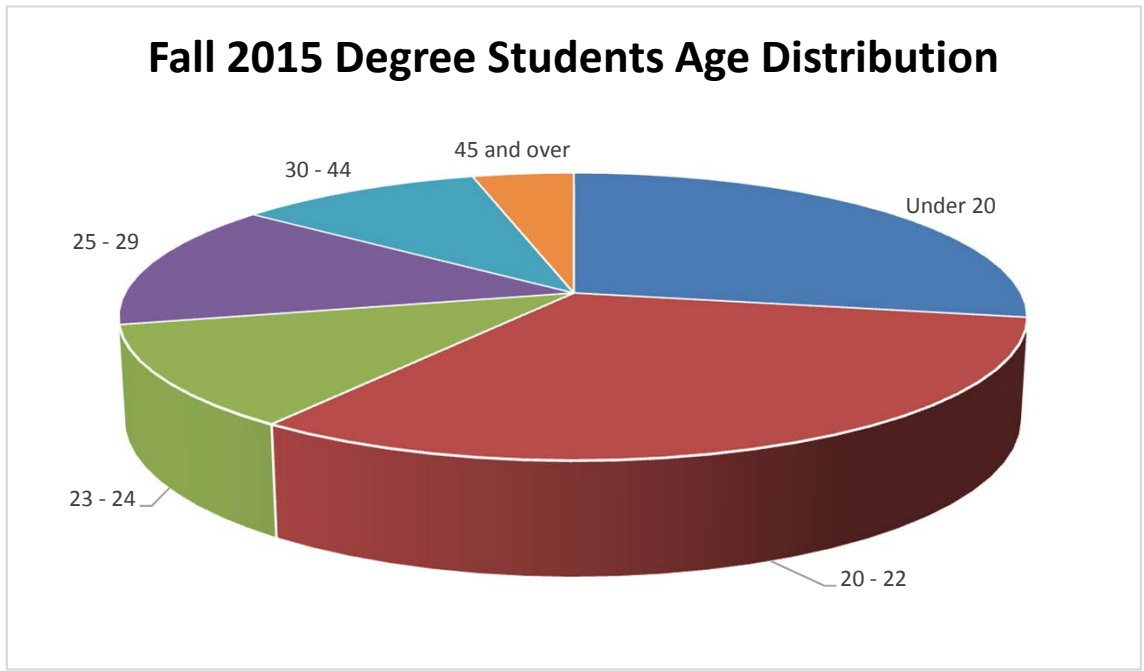

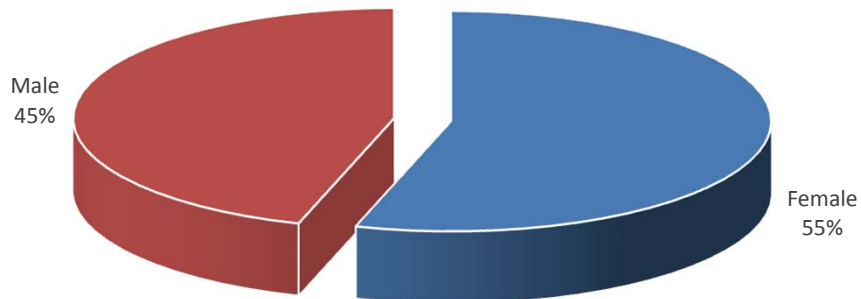

### Fall 2015 Enrollment of Men and Women



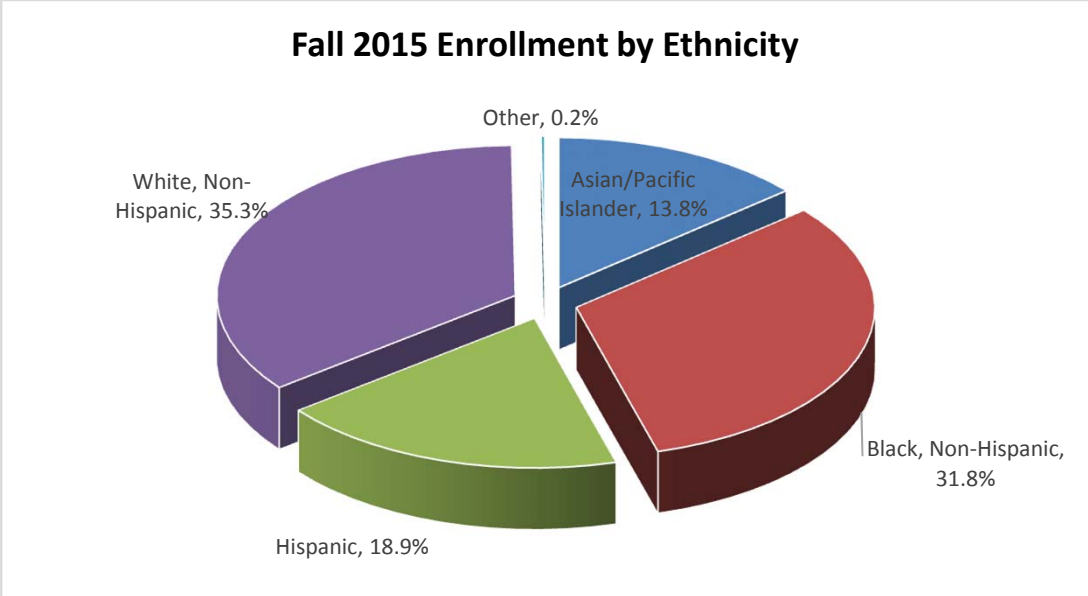

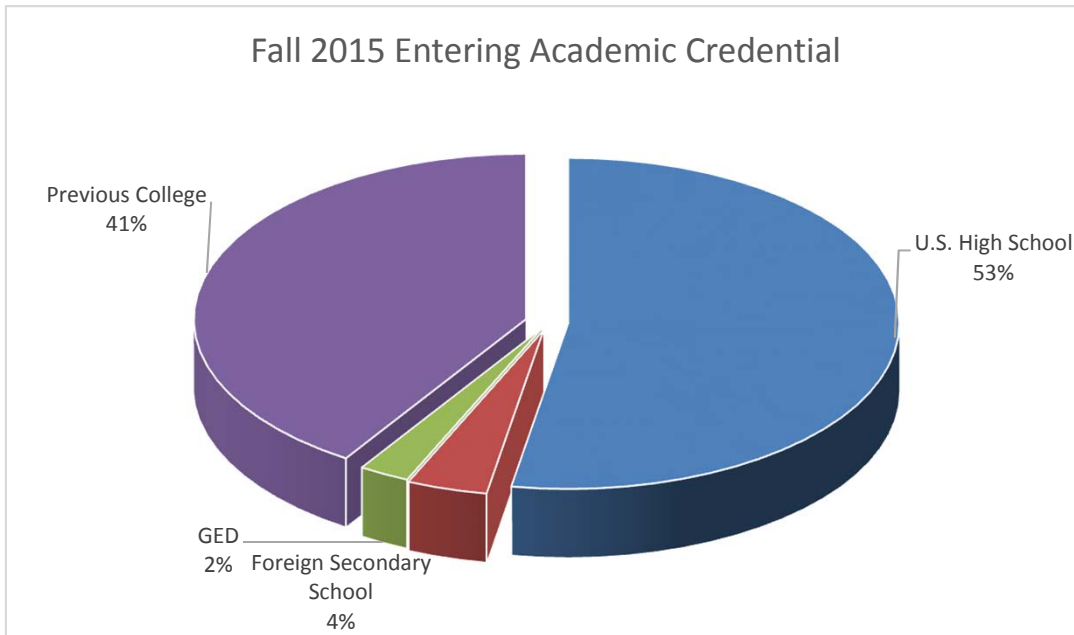

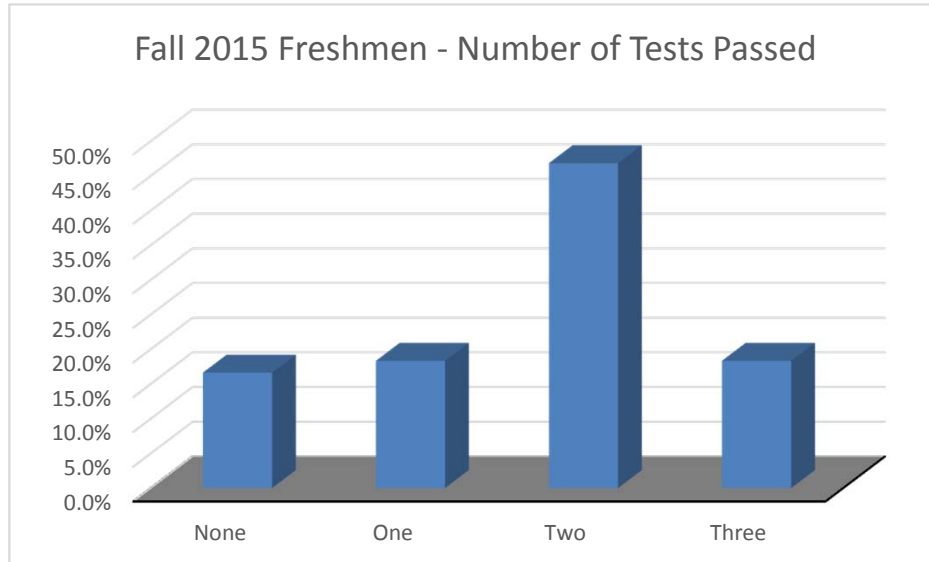

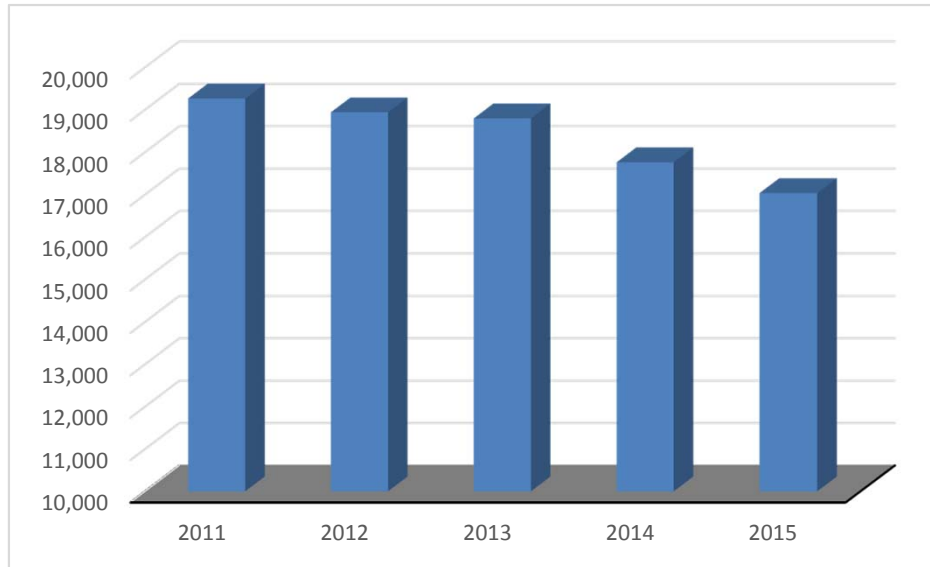

# Credit Students Enrollment Headcount Fall 2011 to Fall 2015



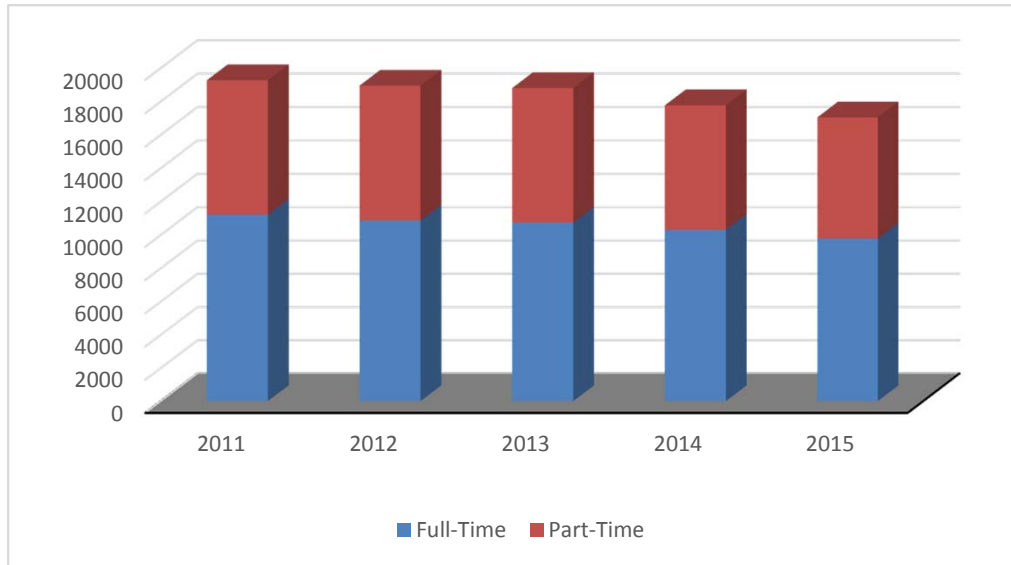

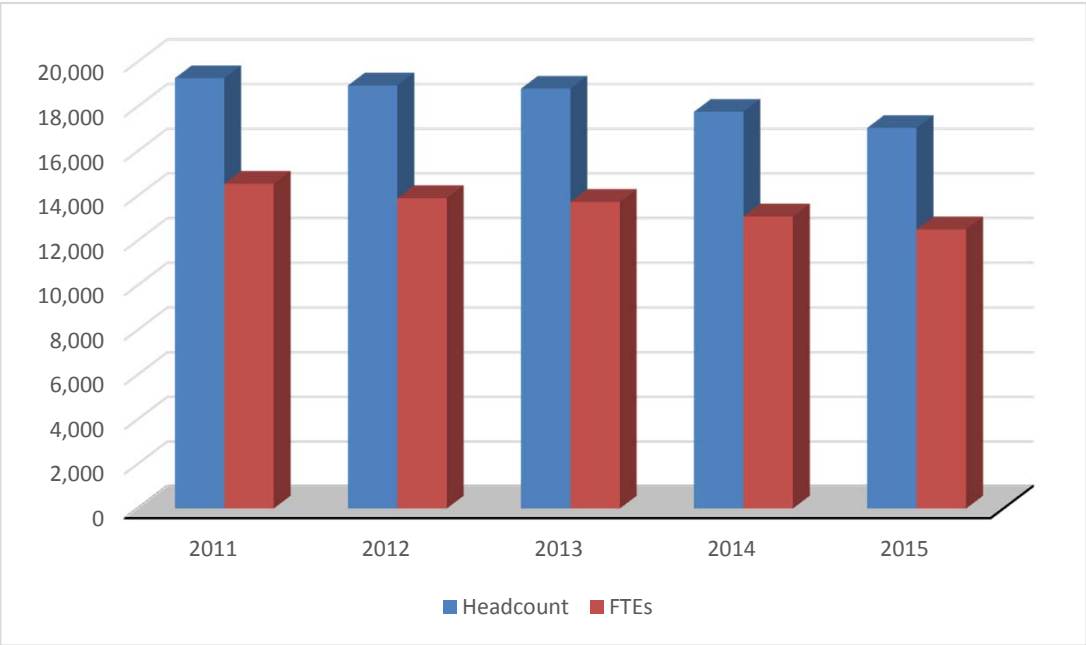

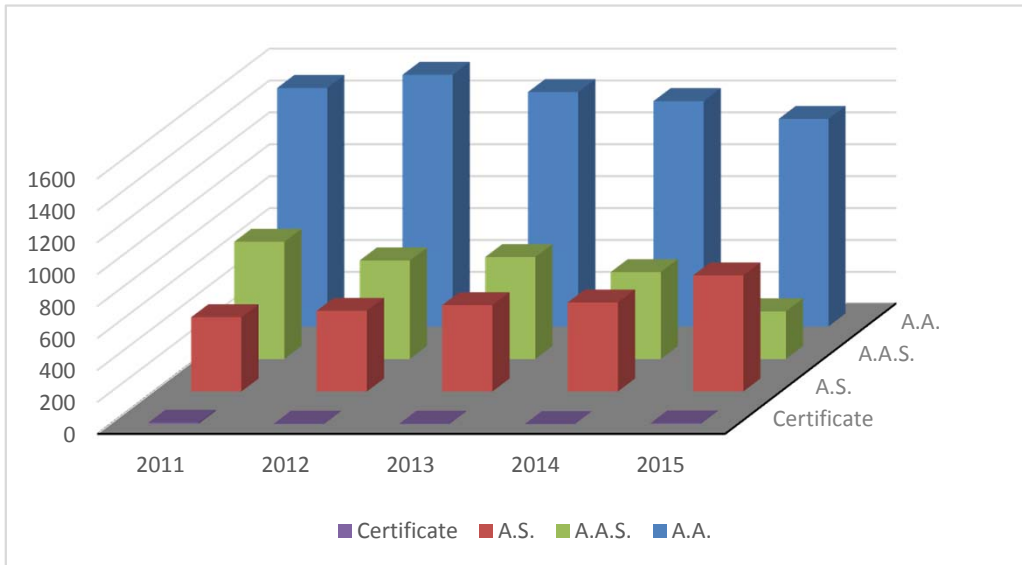

 Fall 2011 to Fall 2015



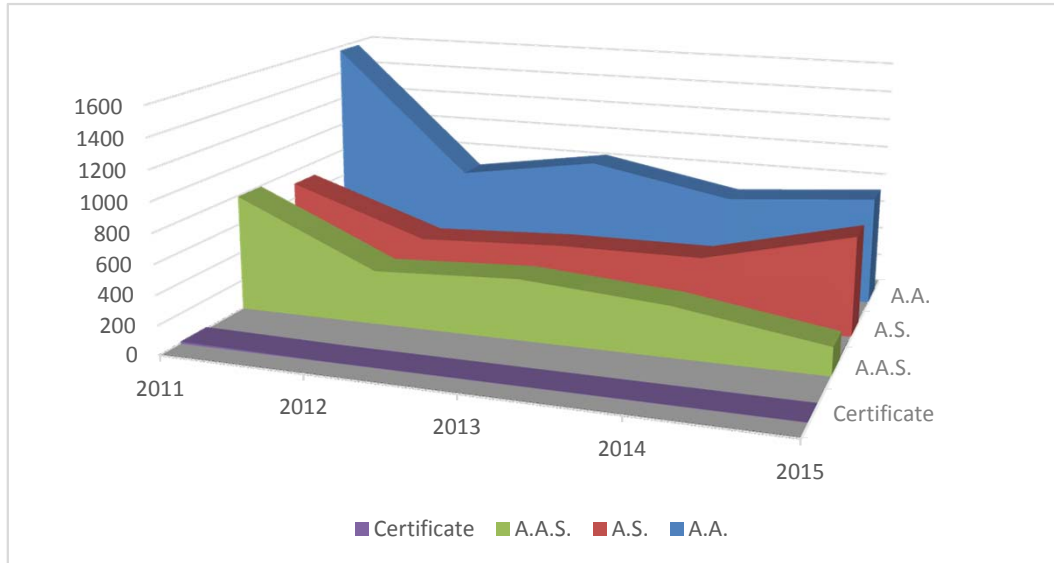

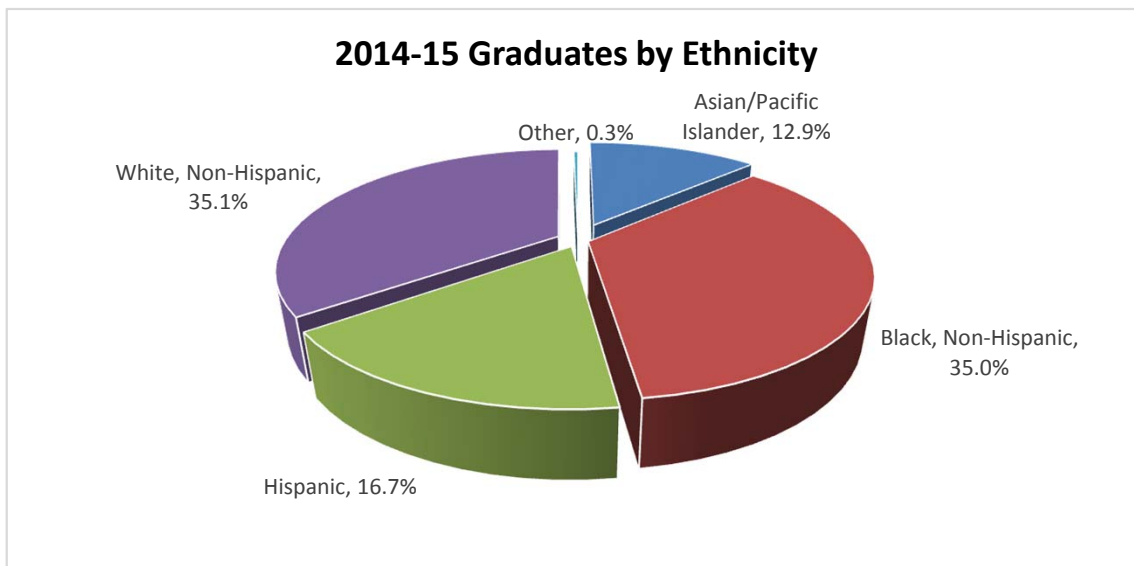

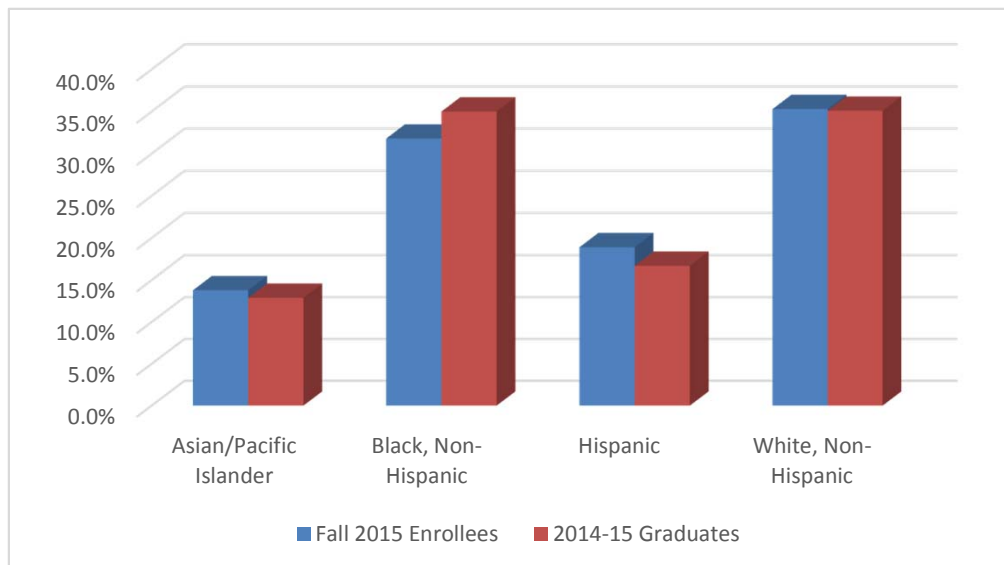

## Comparative Distributions of Graduates and Enrollees By Ethnicity 2014-2015



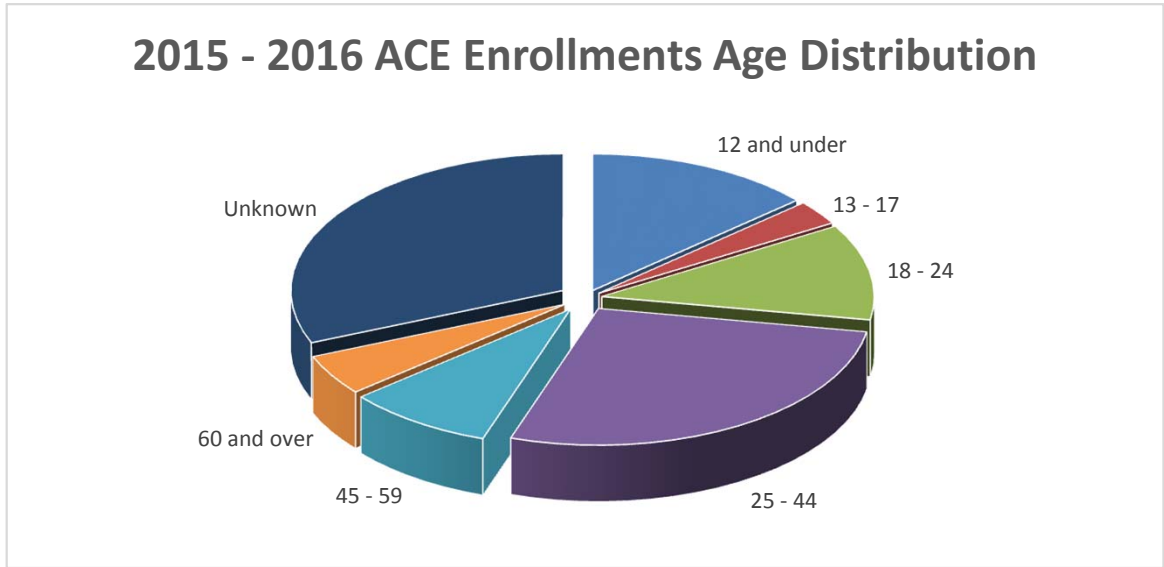

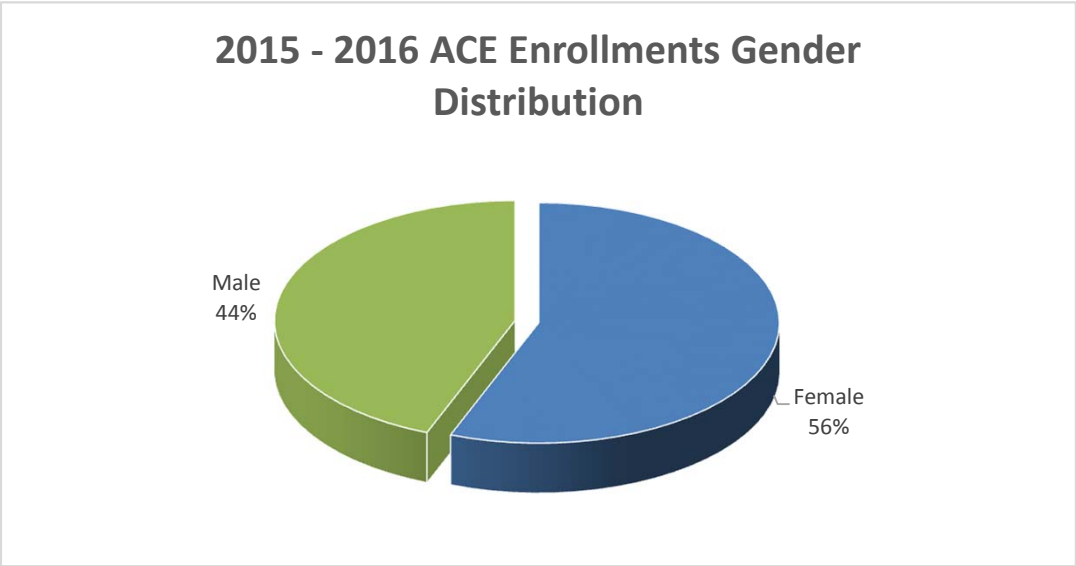

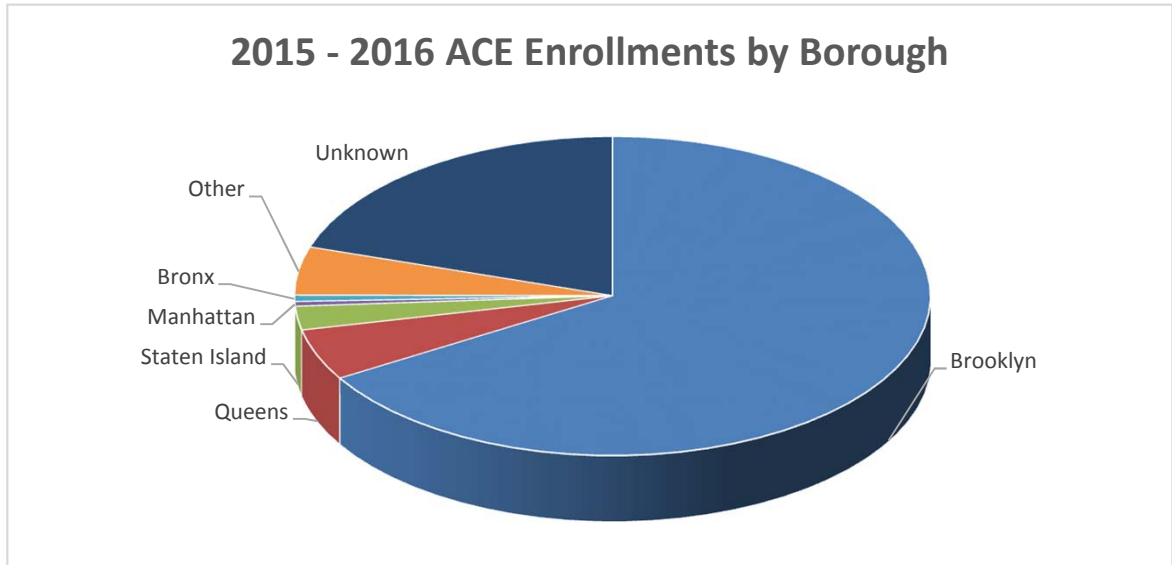
