

- 1) Launch Settings/System Preferences app




- 2) Connect to KCC-Staff WiFi Network

- 1) Launch Settings/System Preferences app




- 2) Connect to KCC-Staff WiFi Network

WiFi Troubleshooting Guide

(Last Updated 11/01/2021)

If you are unable to connect to the WiFi after following our guides, be sure to check the following

- 1) Randomized MAC address should be disabled
 - a. As of Android 10 and iOS/iPadOS 14, Private/Randomized MAC Addresses have been enabled by default, but can be disabled on a per-network basis
 - b. Go to the WiFi settings on either device
 - i. On iOS, select the Info icon associated with the network you are experiencing difficulty with, and uncheck the **Private Address** option
 - ii. On Android OS, select the WiFi network you are experiencing difficulty with, then select Advanced, scroll down to MAC Address Randomization, and select the **Use Phone MAC** option.
- 2) Unable to access Authentication Portal on select Android OS devices
 - a. If you are having trouble accessing the login portal on your Android device, your device is likely failing back to cellular data in order to maintain uninterrupted internet access
 - i. While trying to connect to WiFi, disable cellular data from your control center. This will force your device to remain connected to WiFi in order to reach the login portal.
- 3) "This network has no internet connection"
 - a. There are some situations where roaming back onto the network, users may get told "This network has no internet connection". The portal will come up as a white page. They just need to tell their device to use the network anyway and open a new webpage. It should redirect to KCC webpage if they are already registered.
