Students must take one of the following courses: ECO 12, ECO 20, ANT 37 or Soc 31 (If not already taken above), POL 52, POL 57, and POL 58

Group C (Mathematics and Sciences) 13 - 15 credits

SCI 37 and MAT 20, Plus two of the following courses: BIO 49, SCI 51, EPS 38, BIO 25 or BIO 33

Students may take no more than 3 of the following courses: Foreign Language Level I & II, EPS 38, and BIO 33
