



Repair the World's Service Corps mobilizes adults ages 18-29 to invest both in their communities and themselves through the lens of Jewish values.

Service Corps Members will spend a total of 10 hours per week:

- 1) Volunteering with local service partners, either in-person or virtually
- 2) Learning in Zoom sessions about Jewish approaches to justice and the lasting economic and social effects of the pandemic.

Service Corps Members are paired with a partner organization for 10 weeks to do about a 100 hours of volunteering over the course of the program. They also engage in weekly learning for approximately 2 hours. Upon completion of the program, Service Corps Members will receive a \$1,000 stipend.

Note: Corps Members attending KBCC may be able to gain internship credit through this program.
