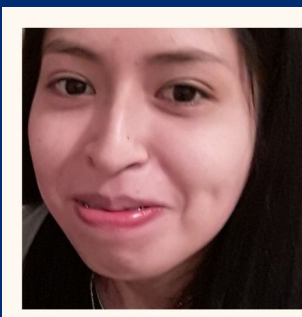

VICE PRESIDENT FOR STUDENT AFFAIRS

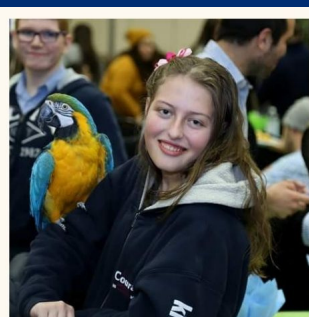

VICE PRESIDENT FOR ACADEMIC AFFAIRS

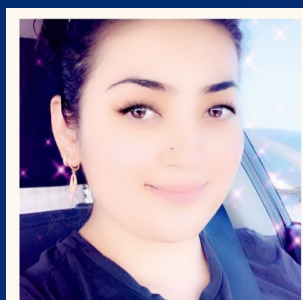
