


**Procedures for reviewing, up-dating, modifying or terminating this agreement:**

- The Department Chairpersons from both programs will review the agreement annually. They will be expected to review student retention, progress to graduation including transitions between prerequisite and transfer courses, degree completion, and GPA. Modification or termination of this agreement requires the approval of both Chief Academic Officers from both institutions.
- Should the agreement be modified or terminated, CSI, School of Health Sciences shall honor the terms granted to students who have already been accepted into and or transferred into the B.S. in Nursing program for a period of four years or graduation, whichever comes first.
- The CSI, School of Professional Studies Registrar and the Nursing Program Chair shall produce reports of the metrics identified above and circulate to the following groups at both institutions:
  - Chief Academic Officer, Associate Provost, Chair of Nursing Department, Director of Student Services, Director of Career Services, and Director of Admission and Advisement.

The CSI, School of Health Sciences and Kingsborough Community College will publicize this opportunity for students in print and web-based materials and in marketing information. Additionally both institutions will provide information to their own recruitment staff members as well as staff at the University Office of Admission Services. The CSI will attend recruiting events on-campus at Kingsborough Community College regularly.


