Re: Amendment No. 1 to Articulation Agreement

Dear Prof. Greenberg:

We refer to the Articulation Agreement (the "Agreement") by and between Kingsborough Community College ("KCC") and Pace University ("Pace") dated as of June 7, 2011. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein have the meaning(s) assigned to them in the Agreement.

For good and valuable consideration, the exchange, receipt, and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged by the parties' countersignatures, below, the Agreement is hereby amended as follows ("Amendment No. 1").

1. The following text is hereby inserted at the bottom of the third page of the Agreement:
"Notwithstanding any term or condition of this Agreement to the contrary, the following courses shall be accepted by Pace University only if the KCC student earned a grade of B- or higher:

Speech 16 Introduction to Communication Disorders
Speech 40 Phonetics
Speech 41 Language Development."

2. The text on the first page of the Agreement entitled Admissions Requirements to Senior College Program is hereby amended to read as follows: "KCC graduates with an A.S. degree in Speech Communication who meet the minimum admission criteria will be granted admission into the Pace University Speech Pathology program."
3. The text numbered 1 on the fourth page of the Agreement under the title Procedures for evaluating agreement, e.g., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success is hereby amended to read as follows: "Each Fall and Spring term, the KCC director shall provide to Pace the names of those students who will be applying Pace for the forthcoming semester."

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall continue unchanged in full force and effect as if this Amendment No. 1 had not been executed.

Please signify KCC's agreement to this Amendment No. 1 by placing your signature on both originals of this Amendment No. 1 in the space provided below for that purpose and thereafter returning one original of this Amendment No. 1 to me. Thank you for your courtesy.

Elective equivalencies:

- KCC students will be encouraged to take Speech 16 – Speech and Language Disorders which will be transferred equivalently to Pace CSD 140-Introduction to Communication Disorders.

Procedures for reviewing, updating modifying or terminating agreement:

1. An annual meeting between the directors of the respective programs will be mutually arranged in order to review, modify and/or terminate this agreement.
2. Communication via email and phone will provide intermittent communication as needed.
3. Notwithstanding term or condition to the contrary contained in this Articulation Agreement, either party may terminate this Articulation Agreement by giving the other party written notice of termination not fewer than thirty (30) days prior to the commencement of a Program semester. In the event that this Agreement is terminated, the parties agree to work together to develop a plan to ensure that students enrolled in the Program pursuant to this Articulation Agreement as of the date of termination shall be eligible to complete their Program studies in accordance with the specifics of the curriculum.

Procedures for evaluating agreement, e.g., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:

1. Each Fall and Spring term, the KCC director will provide the names of those students who will be attending Pace in a forthcoming semester.
2. Each Fall and Spring term, to the extent permitted by applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 ("FERPA"), the Pace director will provide to KCC the name(s) of those KCC students who have successfully completed the Program.


Sending and Receiving College procedures for publicizing agreement, e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisors, Websites, etc.:

1. Both institutions agree to post the articulation on their college websites.
2. Both directors will provide information to the Career and Transfer offices at their respective institutions.

**ADDENDUM A
TO PACE UNIVERSITY-KINGSBOROUGH COMMUNITY COLLEGE
ARTICULATION AGREEMENT**

1. While they are enrolled as Pace University ("Pace") students and/or taking courses at Pace, Program participants are subject to all of the rules, regulations, policies, and procedures contained in such Pace bulletins, catalogues, official websites, and handbooks as are applicable to similarly situated students taking courses at Pace, including, but not limited to, Pace's policies regarding academic standing and continuation, withdrawal, academic integrity, and Information Technology ("IT") Appropriate Use. Notwithstanding term or condition to the contrary contained in this Articulation Agreement, such policies may be modified, supplemented, or withdrawn in Pace's sole discretion at any time, with or without notice.
2. Notwithstanding term or condition to the contrary contained in this Articulation Agreement, Pace shall have sole responsibility, authority and discretion relative to academic standards, allocation of resources, and the participation of Pace personnel in the Program.
3. Nothing contained in this Articulation Agreement shall be deemed to create or constitute a partnership, joint venture, or agency relationship between the parties.

Neither party will be responsible for any failure to fulfill its obligations due to causes beyond its reasonable control, including without limitation, acts or omissions of government or military authority, acts of God, fires, floods, labor disturbances, riots, terrorist attacks, insurrections, or wars. If such an event prevents a party from fulfilling its obligations hereunder, either party may terminate this agreement with written notice to the other party without penalty to such other party. In the event of such termination, the parties agree to work together to develop a plan to ensure that students enrolled in the Program pursuant to this Articulation Agreement as of the date of such termination shall be eligible to complete their Program studies in accordance with the specifics of the curriculum.
