

Articulation Agreement

Between

St. Joseph's College, New York and Kingsborough Community College

This document represents a transfer credit articulation agreement between St. Joseph's College, New York and Kingsborough Community College. This will serve as a guiding document for use by students, faculty and administrators of both institutions in clarifying the relationship between the schools and in confirming the way course credits transfer from Kingsborough Community College to St. Joseph's College, New York. The attached Transfer Articulation Course Equivalencies documents are the result of dialogue between the St. Joseph's College, New York and Kingsborough Community College Academic Deans and Department Chairpersons. Each course equivalent has been reviewed by both parties for content and transferability. The agreement may be modified, including adding or deleting course equivalencies, upon agreement of both parties.

Kingsborough Community College A.A.S. graduates are eligible to receive up to 76 semester hours of transfer credits when transferring to St. Joseph's College, New York. Credit will only be awarded for courses completed with a grade of C or better. Transfer students must have an overall grade point average of 2.5 or better.

The attached articulation agreement serves as a guideline for the maximum number of transfer credits from Kingsborough Community College to St. Joseph's College, New York. Students transferring to St. Joseph's College, New York from Kingsborough Community College with the maximum number of credits will be given the opportunity to complete the requirements for a Bachelor of Science degree within five additional semesters of full-time study. St. Joseph's College, New York liberal arts requirements and course equivalencies for transfer credit purposes are contained within this document.

To complete requirements for the baccalaureate degree, the student is responsible for a minimum of 60 credits in the liberal arts for a B.S. degree. Also attached is an equivalency chart to facilitate analysis of courses of study and of how Kingsborough Community College courses transfer to St. Joseph's College, New York.

Students who transfer are usually expected to complete their course and credit requirements at St. Joseph's College, New York.

To better serve the needs of Kingsborough Community College students who are considering a transfer to St. Joseph's College, New York, to facilitate the admissions and

transfer process, and to ensure that students are provided with the information they need, it is agreed that:

St. Joseph's College, New York (SJC) will:

- Designate an admissions/academic advisor for students transferring to SJC to assist with the admissions and transfer credit process.
- Conduct an "early-bird" registration program specific to Kingsborough Community College transfer students who complete the admissions process by November 1 for the spring term and April 15 for the fall term.
- Provide periodic on-site admissions and advising sessions on the Kingsborough Community College campus for students interested in transferring to SJC when requested.
- Have faculty continue to work with Kingsborough Community College faculty in reviewing additional courses for transferability.
- Designate a financial aid counselor for Kingsborough Community College students transferring to SJC.
- Waive application fee when applying for BSN.
- General Education courses, not offered at Kingsborough Community College but required by SJC, may be completed at SJC while student is currently enrolled at Kingsborough Community College. Student must have a minimum G.P.A. of 2.5 to enroll, and will enter as non-matriculated students.

Kingsborough Community College will:

- Publicize this agreement to students, faculty and professional staff in campus publications.
- Have transfer advisors well versed about this agreement to inform interested students about this opportunity.
- Provide a list of and contact information for graduating students to SJC upon request.
- Ensure that SJC brochures, applications and other printed materials are distributed to the Counseling Centers and the academic departments at Kingsborough Community College.
- Advertise any special programs, events or visits that SJC is offering on the Kingsborough Community College campuses.

This agreement will remain in force until either party wishes to terminate.

Admissions Requirements to St. Joseph's College, New York Program:

1. Minimum G.P.A.: 2.5

- 2. A current license in New York State as a Registered Professional Nurse or eligibility to sit for the NCLEX- RN licensing exam. License must be obtained within one year of enrolling.
- 3. Total credits required at the St. Joseph's College, New York to complete the Baccalaureate Degree: 128
- 4. Total transfer credits allowed: 76
- 5. A minimum grade of 'C' is required for transfer credits.

Additional Benefits under this Agreement

- 1. General Education courses, not offered at Kingsborough Community College but required by SJC, may be completed at SJC while student is currently enrolled at Kingsborough Community College. Student must have a minimum G.P.A. of 2.5 to enroll.
- 2. Application fee waived when applying for BSN.
- 3. Tuition Discount of 23% if 10 students or more enroll in a given semester.
