E. FOLLOW-UP PROCEDURES

• Procedures for reviewing or modifying agreement: When either of the degree programs involved in this agreement undergoes a change, the agreement will be reviewed and revised

accordingly by faculty from each institution's respective departments or programs. It is the responsibility of each college to inform the other institution of the need to update the agreement in response to curriculum changes. Updated copies of the agreement should be signed when a new course catalogue is issued. Requests to terminate an agreement must be submitted in writing and will apply to the following academic year.

- **Procedures for terminating agreement:** Either Institution may terminate this agreement for any reason with ninety (90) days notice. Either Institution may terminate this Agreement in the event of a substantial breach. Every effort should be made to facilitate the transfer of students who enrolled under the agreement before the time of termination.
- Procedures for evaluating agreement impact: Upon request, St. Francis College will provide the Sending Institution with the following information: a) the number of students from the Sending Institution who indicated they were transferring under this agreement and who were accepted and enrolled into SFC; and b) the aggregate GPA of these enrolled students at St. Francis College.
- Procedures for publicizing agreement: This articulation agreement will be publicized on the websites or the Sending and Receiving Institutions. Academic advisors at the Sending Institution will promote this agreement with eligible students (see above).

G. TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIPS:

St. Francis College awards transfer scholarships, merit based aid, and need based aid to eligible students. Please contact the college for more information.
