

Memorandum of Agreement Between
Eastern Suffolk BOCES and Kingsborough Community College

The Board of Cooperative Educational Services of Eastern Suffolk BOCES and Kingsborough Community College Maritime Technology A.A.S. Degree Program hereby establish an articulation agreement for students completing the Career and Technical Education Marine Repair Program for adult students and the Marine/Motorsports Technology Program for secondary students at Eastern Suffolk BOCES. Documentation of prerequisite skills for students and direct benefits offered at Kingsborough Community College are listed below.

*Please note; In order for a BOCES student to achieve articulation in the above-named program at Kingsborough Community College, the following criteria must be met:

- Applicant must be a high school graduate
- Applicant must maintain a 90% attendance rate at BOCES and final grade of a minimum of 80%
- Applicant must receive a Certificate of Completion from Tech program

If the above criteria are satisfied and the applicant meets all other entrance requirements for Kingsborough Community College's Maritime Technology A.A.S. Degree Program, students may be eligible for up to 8 credits in the following areas:
