## THREE STEPS FROM JANUARY TO JUNE

- 3. June:** Revise your syllabus based on your experience piloting and submit a final certification course portfolio by June 30th.

**Option A:** An on-campus f2f workshop series of 9 interactive sessions. Please reserve Reading Day, December 12th, 2018 and Mondays and Thursdays from 1 to 3:30 PM during the Winter 2019 term. Read, write, talk. Post your homework on a personal blog.

**Option B:** On-line tutorial with 9 modules of reading/writing assignments.

Work from home using a personal blog and a course site blog for discussion. For those who are computer savvy and able to maintain a strict posting schedule in January & February.
